SUMMARY OF MOTIONS

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- 1 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to approve
2 the minutes of the 11/25/08 Council meeting. The
3 motion was seconded by Councilmember Pittman. The
4 motion was passed by a 5-1 vote, Councilmember
5 Spangler dissenting.
- 6 A motion was made by Councilmember Alexander to
7 approve the minutes of the 12/1/08 Council meeting.
8 The motion was seconded by Councilmember Roche. The
9 motion was passed by an affirmative vote of 5, with
10 Councilmember Bates abstaining.
- 11 A motion was made by Councilmember Spangler to use GMA
12 debt recovery systems (Penn Credit) to collect certain
13 outstanding utilities and taxes due the City. The
14 motion was seconded by Councilmember Roche. The
15 motion was passed by unanimous vote.
- 16 A motion was made by Councilmember Fleming to put an
17 ethics complaint on tonight's Council agenda. The
18 motion was seconded by Councilmember Roche. No
19 further action was taken.
- 20 A motion was made by Councilmember Fleming to put a
21 personnel issue on tonight's agenda. The motion was
22 seconded by Councilmember Roche. The motion died due
23 to a tie vote of 3-3, with dissenting votes from

17 Councilmember Alexander, Councilmember Bates and
Councilmember Pittman.

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19 A motion was made by Councilmember Spangler to request
20 the sanitation company to roll back rates to the same
21 level as prior to the last fuel-surcharge rate
increase, to become effective for the next quarter's
sanitation bills which will be issued in January. The
motion was seconded by Councilmember Roche and passed
by unanimous vote.

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4 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to approve a
5 resolution authorizing application for DOT state aid
6 grant for sidewalks and sidewalk repairs up to
\$750,000. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
Roche and passed by unanimous vote.

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8 A motion was made by Councilmember Roche to grant
9 variances requested for 3604 Wilton Avenue, with
conditions, amendments and additions as stated by
staff and agreed to by the applicant. The motion was
10 seconded by Councilmember Bates and passed by
unanimous vote.

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12 A motion was made by Councilmember Spangler to
13 postpone the public hearing for O-I/O-W zoning until
the January 5th Council meeting due to the lateness of
the hour. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
Roche and passed by unanimous vote.

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15 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to go into
16 Executive Session for pending and future litigation.
The motion was seconded by Councilmember Roche and
passed by unanimous vote.

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18 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to come out
19 of Executive Session. The motion was seconded by
Councilmember Fleming and passed by unanimous vote.
