- Utilizes private donations to match public funds allocated for trail development
- Raised over \$100 million from private sector for trail development
- Postured \$200 Million to be allocated from public sector for trails

- Built 300 miles of bike/ped facilities in the southeast

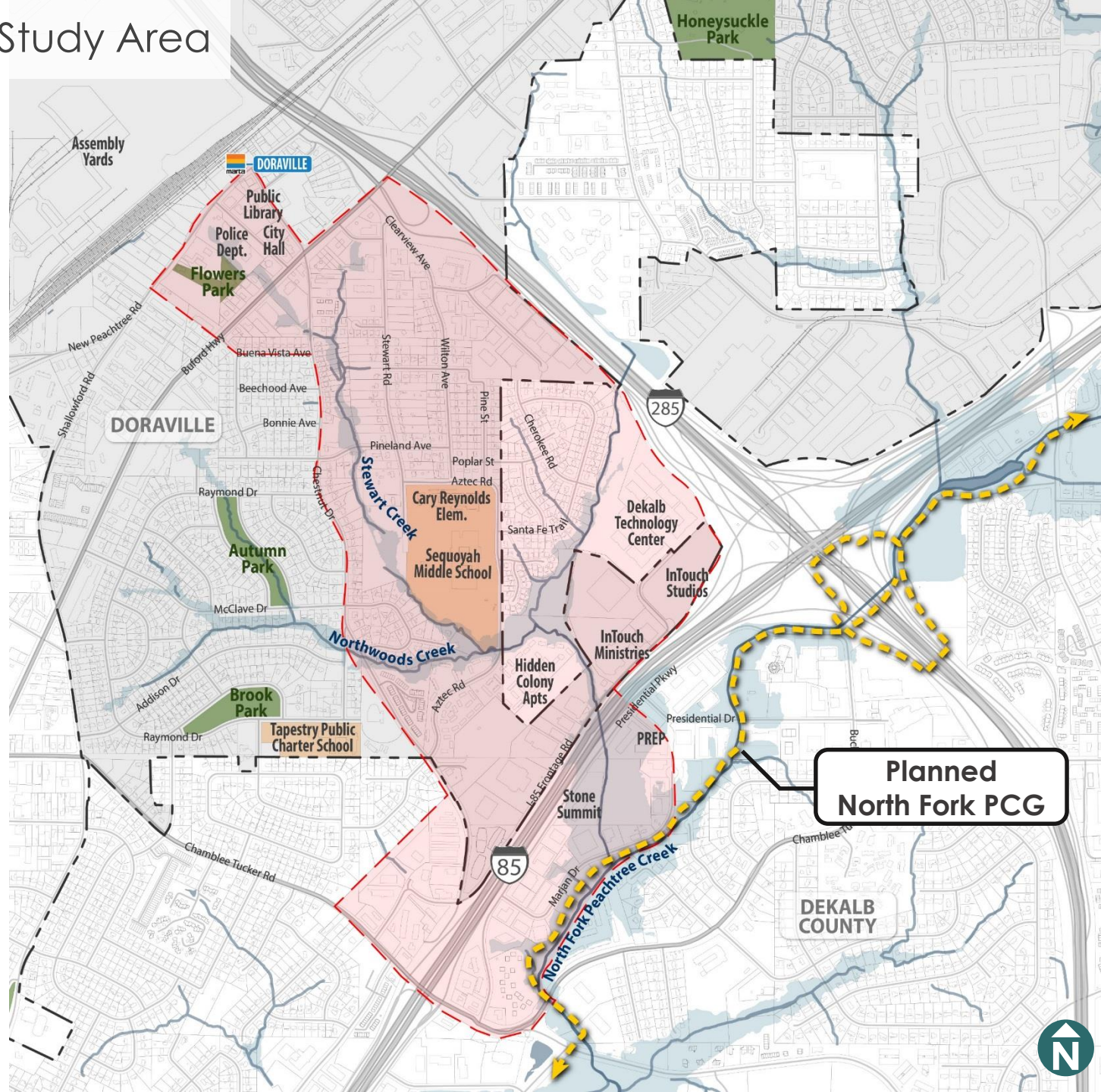

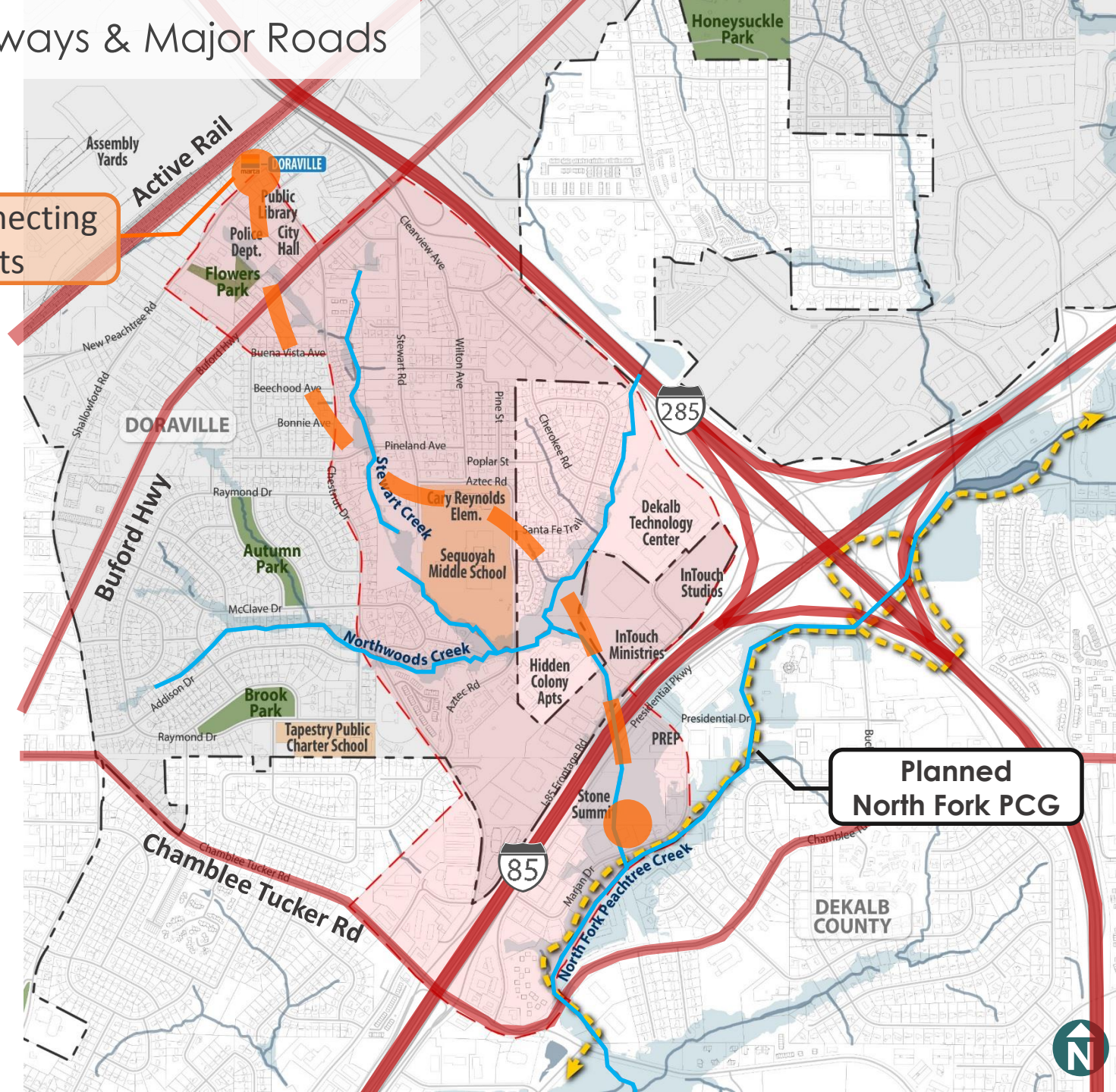

Identify opportunities to connect the community to nature and greenspace.



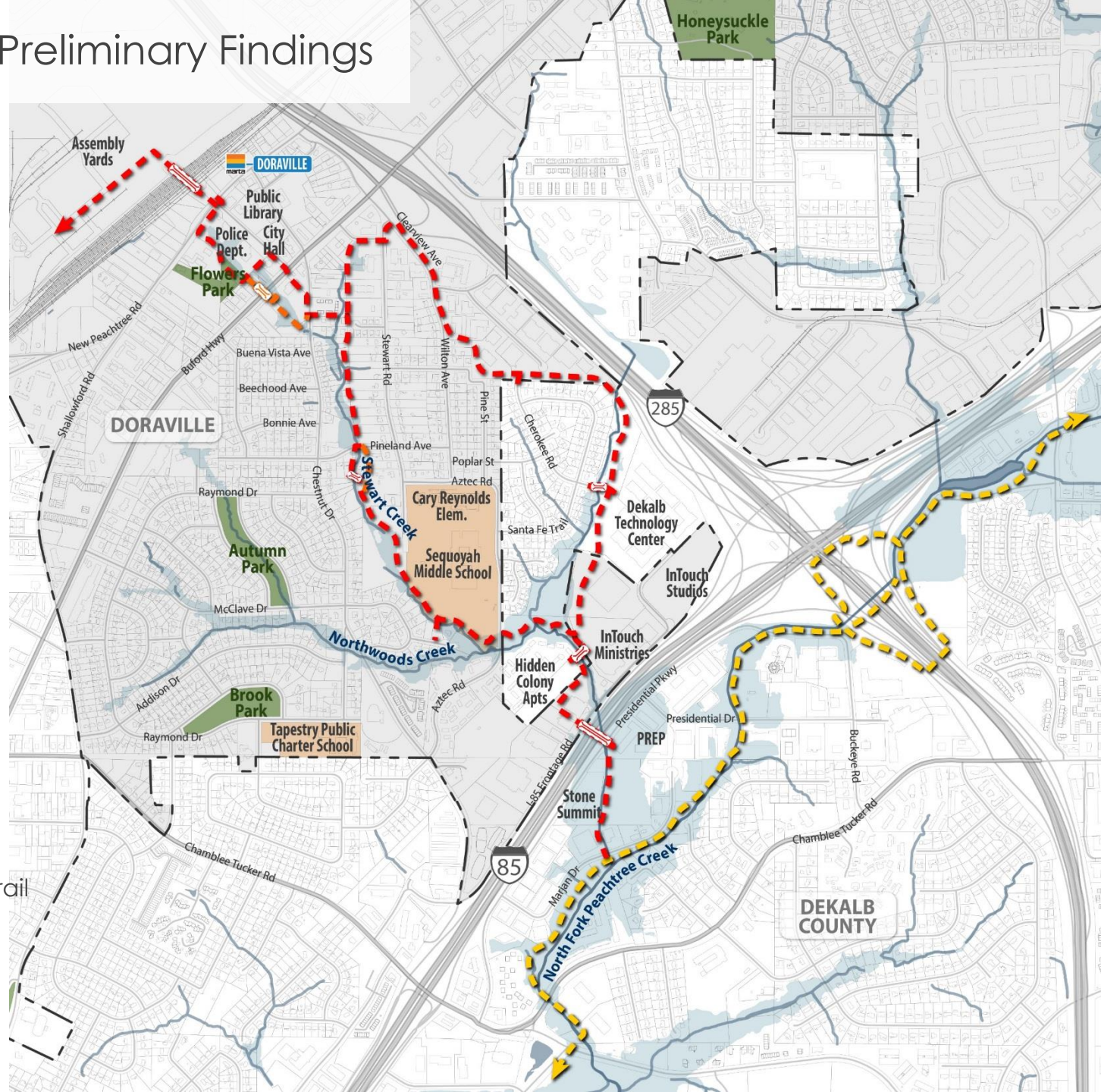

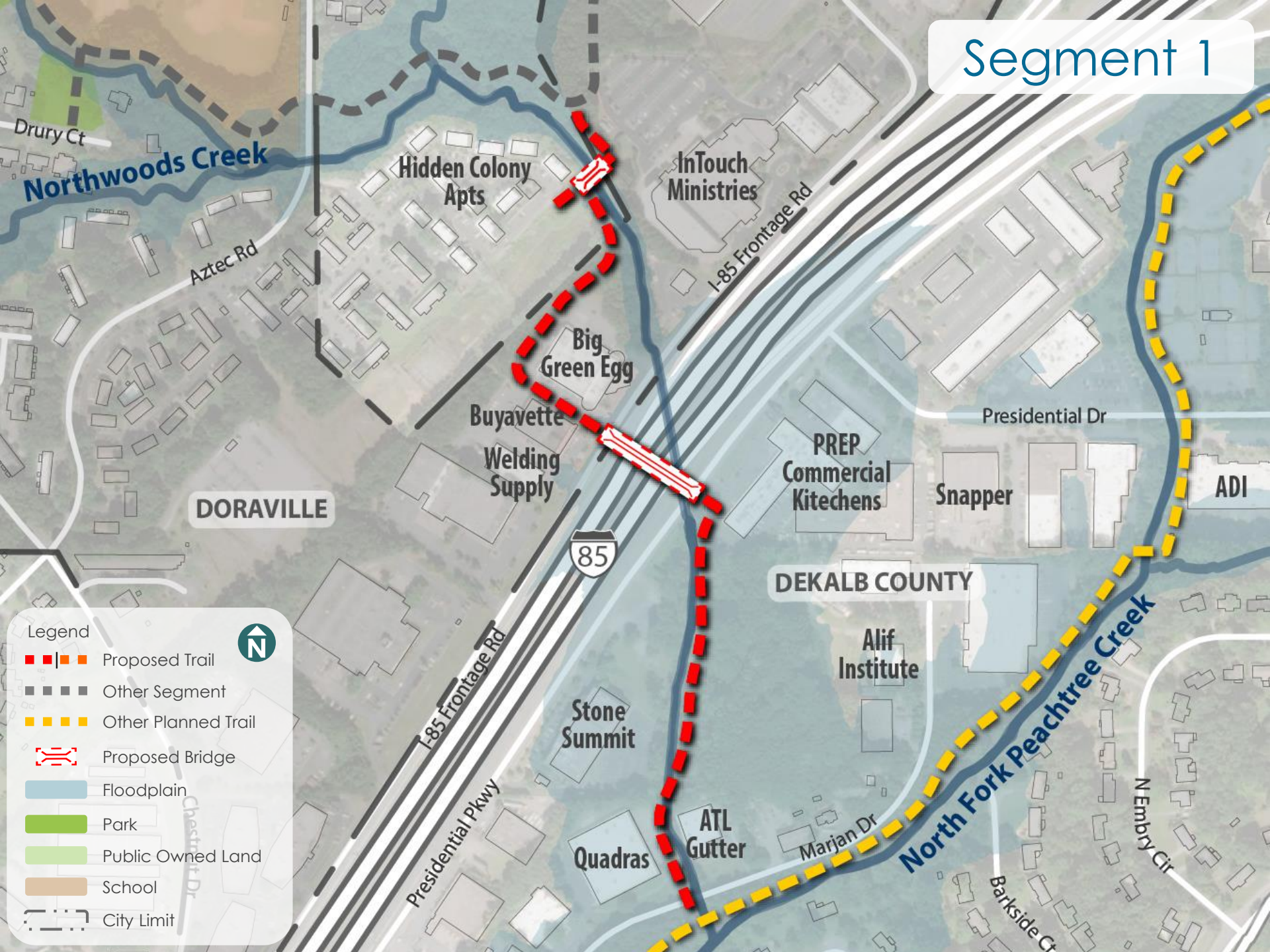
Segment 1 – N Fork PCG to Sequoyah Mid School



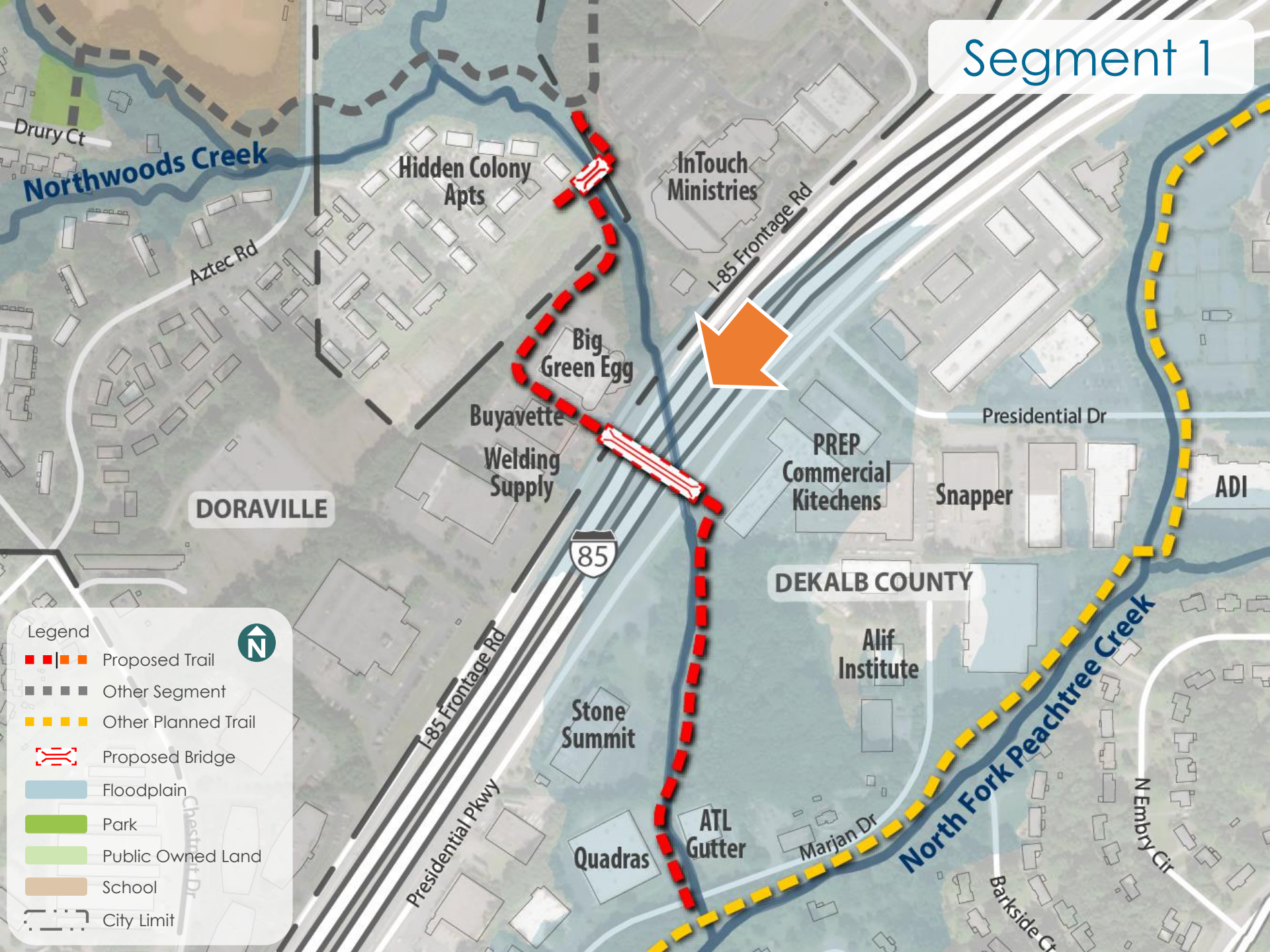

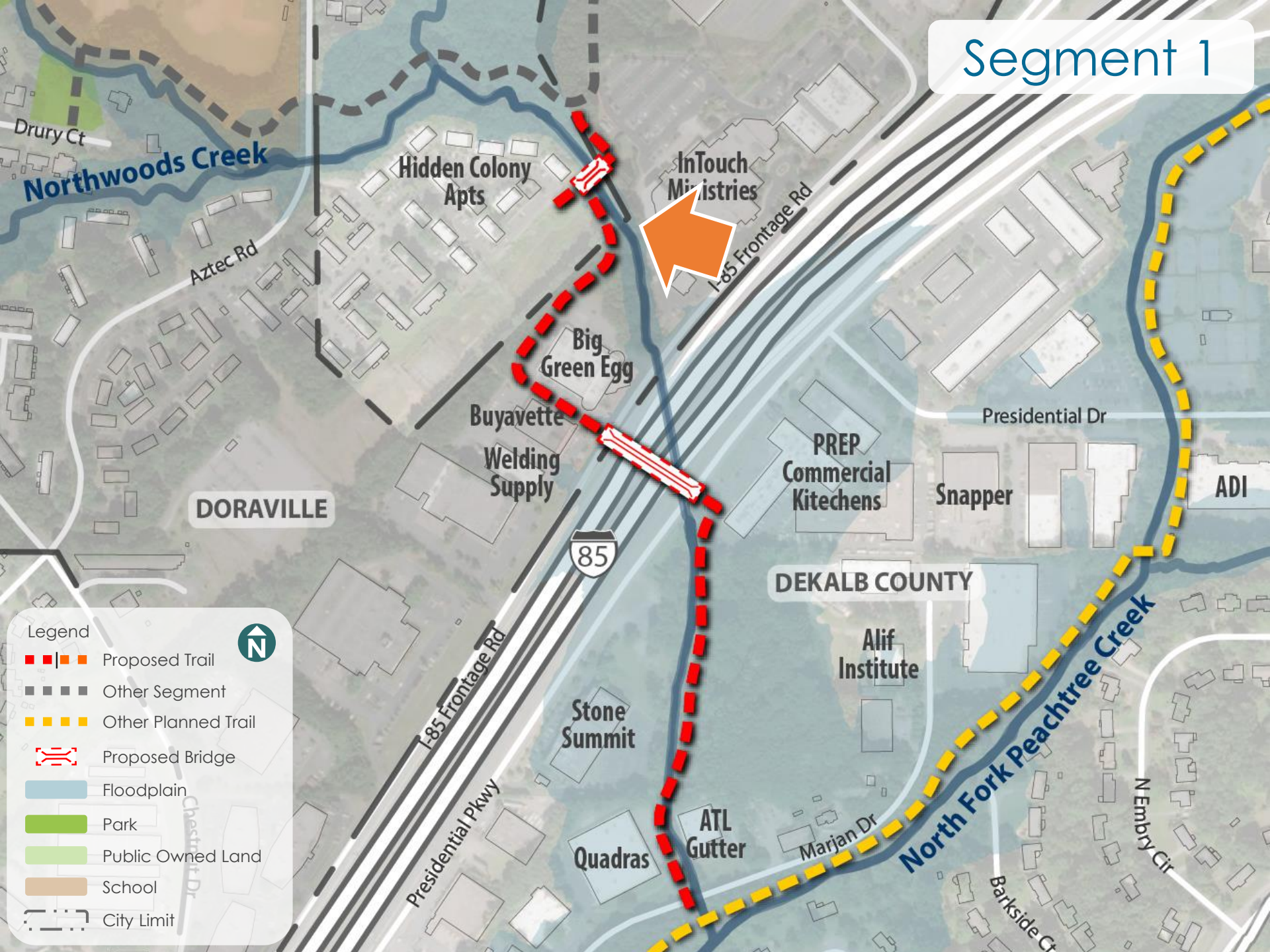

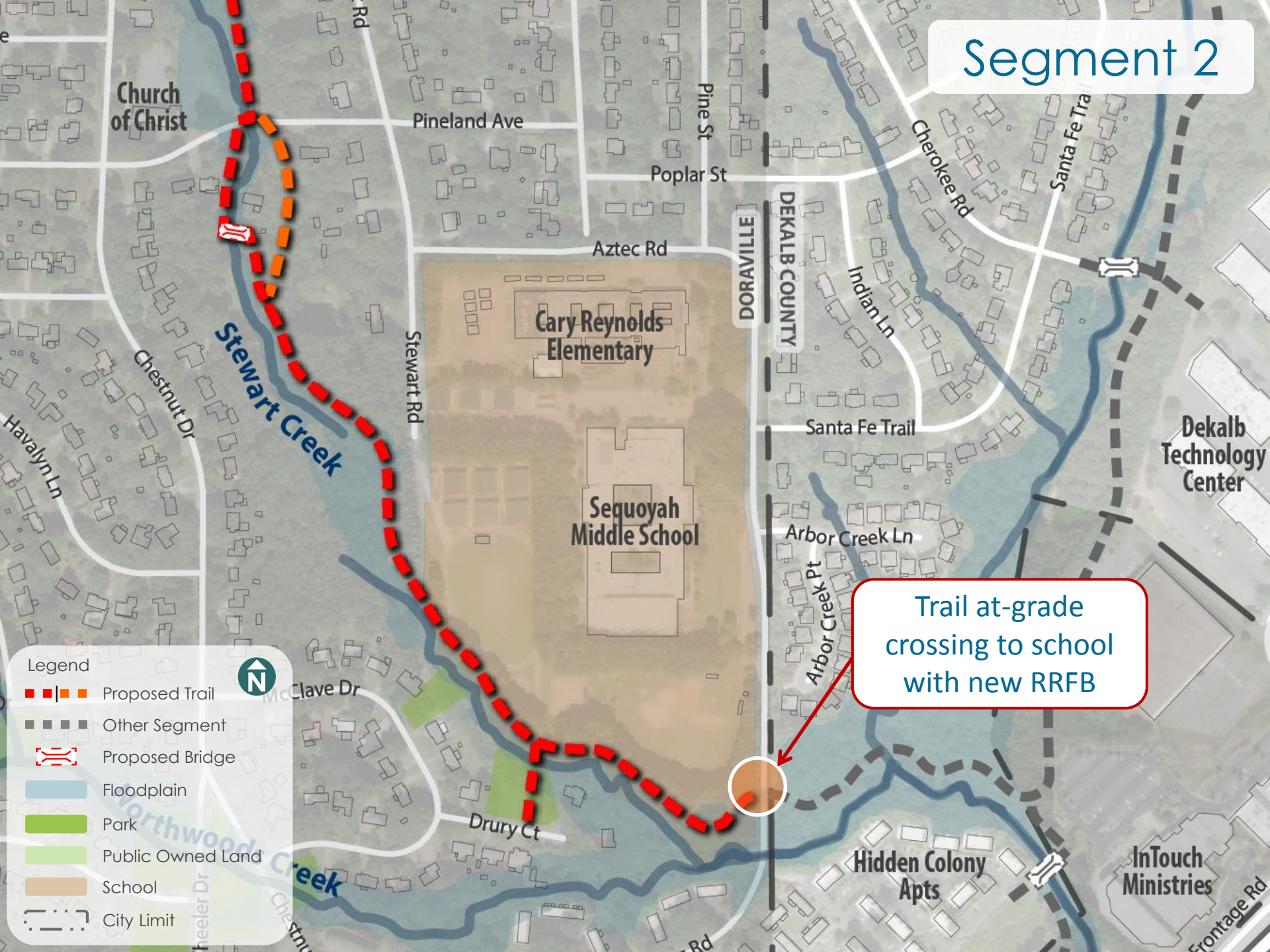

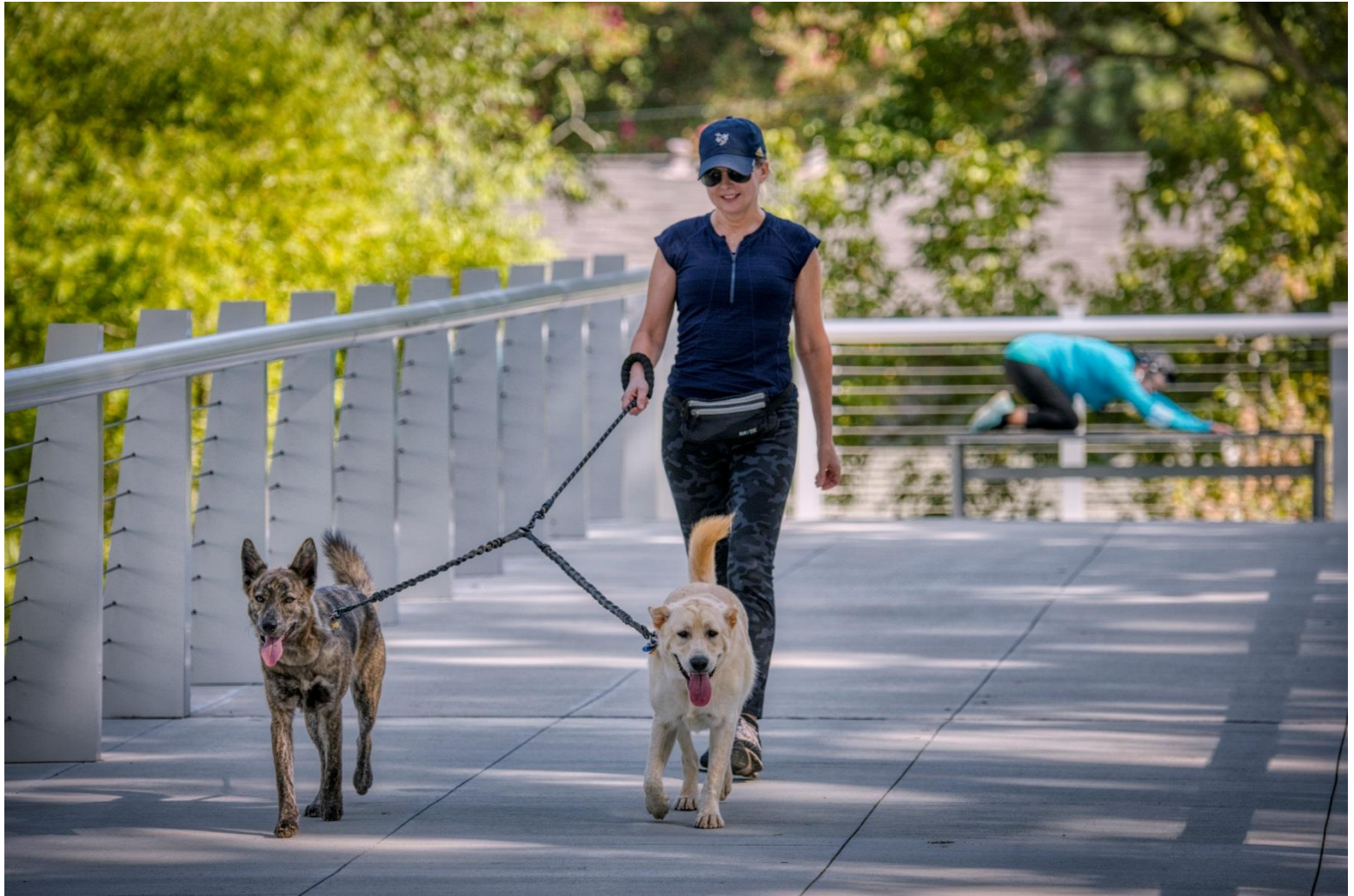
What's next?
