

Soil Erosion & Sediment Discharge Reporting!!

We all care about the environment and the area we live in. We want to do what is best for the environment we all live and play in. So, let's not tolerate activities which pollute the rivers, lakes and streams in our county. When pollutants (i.e. sediment, debris, fluids, and petroleum products) are discharged from construction activity it is a violation of Michigan's Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Laws (Part 91 of PA 451 of 1994) and the pollutants entering storm drain system, streams, or drainage ditches, harm our watershed. **County, municipal, or school district employees witnessing** these conditions are to notify the **St. Clair County Health Department's Division of Environmental Health:**
