- M. Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 611 Section 2 (d) to read: It shall be unlawful for persons under the age of 21 to enter, patronize, visit, be admitted to, or allowed access in any alcoholic beverage establishment between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., except as hereinafter provided
