Krajewski moved to approve the tax correction for the homestead exemption change and authorize Chairperson Ervin to sign, Crandall seconded the motion. Anderson, Schroeder, Crandall, Krajewski and Ervin voting aye; none voting nay; motion carried. Crandall moved to approve the tax correction for accelerating the taxes and authorize Chairperson Ervin to sign, Anderson seconded the motion. Schroeder, Krajewski, Anderson, Crandall and Ervin voting aye; none voting nay; motion carried.
