Zoning Administration for Keith County, Amber Kuskie appeared before the Board with a resolution for the Final Plat of Vowers Administrative Replat of Tracts 17 & 23, Yucca Heights Subdivision. Todd Kramer spoke to the Board regarding the lot line on this property. Kramer said that the realtor handling the sale for him gave an incorrect legal description for the deed and they will need to correct it. Schroeder moved to deny the Final Plat of Vowers Administrative Replat of Tracts 17 & 23, Yucca Heights Subdivision, Ervin seconded the motion. This resolution of denial will be filed in the Resolution Book as number 2021-91.

Pamela Mann with Region II Developmental Disabilities and Mary Lawson with PAKS gave the Board their Annual Report.

Olson spoke to the Board about allowing employees to go to Banner Health for their annual blood draw. Olson told the Board that the new company that would be doing the blood draw for the county would in addition to the blood draw fee be charging for mileage and lodging. Ervin will contact Spencer Thomas with Novo Benefits and Banner Health to see if this is a possibility.

The Board gave reports and received correspondence. The Board received July's fee reports from the Clerk's Office and the Clerk of the District Court's Office.

The Board received a budget request from Bridge of Hope. The Board will take the request under consideration when working on the budget.

With no further business to come before the Board the meeting was adjourned. The Board will meet again Wednesday, August 11, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. at the Courthouse in Ogallala.
