Vice Chairperson Dale Schroeder opened the Board of Equalization meeting. Roll call was answered by Dale Schroeder, Vice Chairperson and Commissioners Corey Crandall, Lane Anderson and Toney Krajewski. Chairperson Joan Ervin was absent. Also attending the meeting were County Clerk Sandra Olson and County Assessor Renae Zink. Anderson moved to approve the agenda, Krajewski seconded the motion. Crandall, Krajewski, Anderson and Schroeder voting aye; Ervin absent; none voting nay; motion carried. Anderson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, Crandall seconded the motion. Krajewski, Crandall, Anderson and Schroeder voting aye; Ervin absent; none voting nay; motion carried.

Zink presented the Board with Overs/Unders. Crandall moved to approve the Overs/Unders as presented, Anderson seconded the motion. Krajewski, Anderson, Crandall and Schroeder voting aye; Ervin absent; none voting nay; motion carried.

At 7:37 a.m. Anderson stepped out of the meeting to do a call in interview on the radio.

Zink also presented the Board with Tax Corrections. Crandall moved to approve the Tax Corrections, Krajewski seconded the motion. Krajewski, Crandall and Schroeder voting aye; Anderson and Ervin absent; none voting nay; motion carried.

Zink went over the letter the Clerk's Office will hand out to protesters from the Board. The Board suggested changing the letter to state evidence not presented five days prior to the hearing date will not be considered for the protest.

It was decided that June 14th, 21st and 28th will be for protest hearings of residential properties, July 6th will be for protest hearings of Commercial and Ag properties and July 12th and 19th will be for protest hearings of all properties.

Anderson returned to the meeting at 7:53 a.m.

It was decided that the Board of Equalization meetings will begin at 10:15 a.m. with the first protest to be held at 10:20 a.m.

With no further business to come before the Board the meeting was adjourned.
