Also attending the meeting were County Clerk Sandra Olson and County Attorney Randy Fair. Crandall acknowledged the Open Meeting Act was posted. Krajewski moved to approve the agenda, Anderson seconded the motion. Anderson, Krajewski and Crandall voting aye; Ervin and Schroeder absent; none voting nay; motion carried.
