Further, certain USACE staff members assigned to the "Project Team" have transitioned to different positions, left their positions with the Corps or are now assigned to other projects.

Mr. Morton will give a more detailed account of the status of the Levee Project, but it would appear Lander County is now in a position where a political solution, utilizing the resources of the Furman Group, must be the primary option for consideration. The Commission should establish the position that the Project is vital and necessary to the Town of Battle Mountain and formally request the assistance of the Nevada Congressional Delegation in obtaining Project-specific funding for the USACE Sacramento District Office to elevate the priority and continue work on the Project.

Background:

Executive Director Gene Etcheverry will give the Commission an update and status report on the Austin Loneliest Highway Visitors Center Project.

The 'hardship' letter written to Ms. Martinovich, Director, and other staff members of the Nevada Department of Transportation, (NDOT), was confirmed to be received by all recipients and has received a recommendation for additional funding from Kirsten Kehe, P.E., Local Public Agency Project Coordinator. The amount of additional funding recommended is \$100,000.00.

Review of the letter also resulted in an apparent reversal of an earlier NDOT decision under which the value of the land (contributed for the Project by the Marshall family) could not be considered as match funding toward the total project cost. It now appears that the land value of \$18,500.00 can be considered as partial Fander County match funding. (The land value was included as County match in the original Project Application at a value of \$32,433.00.)

Assuming approval of the recommendation for additional funding to the Project by Ms. Martinovich, an Amended Local Public Agency Project Agreement will be drafted to reflect additional funding in the total amount of \$118,500.00. This will bring the total (current) project funding available to \$527,900.00, slightly under the original construction cost estimate of \$533,297.00.

The recommendation of Ms. Kehe is that provision of the additional funding be conditioned as follows:

- 1. Lander County remain committed to provide \$32,433.00 in match funding.
- 2. The 90% Design be received by NDOT on an immediate time frame.
- 3. The Project be out to bid by August 15, 2012.

Dear Honorable Commissioners.

Two seats are now vacant on the Kingston Town Board. One is seat C, formally occupied by Ronald Palmer, who resigned in April 2012. The other is seat A, formally occupied by Dennis Lundberg, who also resigned in April 2012. These two seats are both up for reelection this fall and the individuals who registered to run as candidates for these seats are running unopposed. Ann Miles is running for seat C and Betty Kemp for seat A.

At the meeting on April 25, 2012 the board voted unanimously to ask the Lander County Commissioners to appoint these individuals to fill the seats that they have already registered for. At this time the board only has three members and it can be difficult to get business completed if there is illness or travel.



You may not recognize the company name on the letterhead but we think it may become familiar quickly. GRE Inc. will soon be in your county locating, assessing and surveying abandoned mines on BLM land.

GRE, Inc. is an acronym for Gold Rush Expeditions Established in Salt Lake City. Utah in 2004 GRE specializes in surveying, assessment and documentation of abandoned mines across the western states. Our work includes underground mapping and staking claims on available properties where we feel there is still value. We survey approximately 400 abandoned mines per month. Of those 400, we justially claim about 20%.

The reason for this letter is two-fold, first we wanted to emphasize the economic value of our presence. Here are a few facts

- 1. A customer that purchases a mine from GRE usually spends about \$3,700.00 on their initial trip to visit their mine. This is spent in fuel food supplies, tires, etc. and most is spent in the same county that their mine is in.
- 2. An average customer visits their mine site 2 times per year. Their average expenses, in county, are \$1975.00 per trip Again, this is in fuel, food, and supplies.
- 3. About 8% of our customers engage in actively in mining their sites. These individuals and companies spend an average of \$47,000.00 per year in equipment, fuel, and permits. Their employees usually spend the majority of their pay in or around the county where they are stationed.
- 4. Small scale mining has little or no impact on the surrounding cities of their environment.



Enclosed for your review and comment is the Newmont Mining Corporation, Phoenix Copper Leach Project abbreviated Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS), prepared by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Mount Lewis Field Office. The Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) was issued for public review and comment on October 28, 2011. The DEIS analyzed the direct, indirect, and cumulative impacts associated with the proposed construction and operation of the Phoenix Copper Leach Project.

The DEIS was commented on by region IX of the Environmental Protection Agency (the EPA), the Nevada Department of Wildlife (the NDOW), and various Nevada State Agencies through the Nevada State Clearinghouse. Various Lander County, Nevada economic organizations provided comment letters in support of approving the project as analyzed in the DEIS. Eight private citizens also provided letters supporting approval of the project as analyzed in the DEIS. The BLM did not receive any substantive comments from any other individuals or organizations on the DEIS.

The abbreviated FEIS is comprised of minor changes and corrections to the DEIS, the substantive comment letters, and the BLM's responses to those comments. The DEIS was not substantively changed because of the comments that were provided to the BLM. In order for a reviewer to fully understand the abbreviated FEIS, the reviewer must also have a copy of the DEIS, so the reviewer may compare the abbreviated FEIS to the DEIS.

Upon issuance of the Notice of Availability in the <u>Federal Register</u> for the Phoenix Copper Leach project FEIS by the EPA, a 30-day review period will begin. This review period is not considered a comment period under procedures of the National Environmental Policy Act (the NEPA). Should a reviewer or Federal Agency wish to provide comments during this 30-day review period, the BLM may consider addressing any substantive comments by incorporating any changes provided in the BLM's Record of Decision or the BLM may consider preparing a supplemental DEIS or FEIS. Should another Federal Agency reconsider its position on the Phoenix Copper Leach Project and advise the BLM of such a change during the 30-day review period, the BLM may consider that Federal Agency's position change and address that change in

the same manner, i.e., changes to the Record of Decision or preparing a supplemental DEIS or FEIS.

Should you choose to provide comments to the BLM on the abbreviated FEIS please remember that your entire comment, including your address, phone number, e-mail address, or other personal identifying information might be made publicly available at any time. While you can ask us in your comment to withhold your personal identifying information from public review, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to do so. In addition, information will be posted online at the BLM website, http://www.blm.gov/nv/st/en/fo/battle_mountain_field.html. You may also download the FEIS from this web site.

The review period provides community officials and citizens in the affected communities with an opportunity to identify changes or corrections to non-technical information, such as corporate limits, road names, and stream names on the FIRM panels or in the FIS report.

To assist your community in maintaining the FIRM, we have enclosed a Summary of Map Actions (SOMA) to document previous Letters of Map Change (LOMCs) (i.e., Letters of Map Amendment [LOMAs], Letters of Map Revision [LOMRs]) that will be superseded when the FIRM becomes effective. Information on LOMCs is presented in the following four categories: (1) LOMCs for which results have been included on the FIRM; (2) LOMCs for which results could not be shown on the FIRM because of scale limitations or because the LOMC issued had determined that the lots or structures involved were outside the SFHA as shown on the FIRM; (3) LOMCs for which results have not been included on the FIRM because the flood hazard information on which the original determinations were based is being superseded by new flood hazard information; and (4) LOMCs issued for multiple lots or structures where the determination for one or more of the lots or structures cannot be revalidated through an administrative process like the LOMCs in Category 2 above.

LOMCs in Category 2 will be revalidated through a single letter that reaffirms the validity of a previously issued LOMC; the letter will be sent to your community shortly before the effective date of the FIRM panels and will become effective one day after the FIRM panels becomes effective.

For the LOMCs listed in Category 4, we will review the data previously submitted for the LOMA or LOMR request and issue a new determination for the affected properties after the FIRM panels becomes effective upon request.

After the CCO Meeting, we will initiate a statutory 90-day appeal period for certain communities within Lander County. A statutory 90-day appeal period is required when FEMA adds or modifies Base (1-percent-annual-chance) Flood Elevations (BFEs), base flood depths, SFHAs, flood zone designations, or regulatory floodways within a community, as shown on the Preliminary FIRM. If your community is identified as requiring an appeal period, we will send you a letter approximately 2 weeks before the start of the 90-day appeal period to detail the appeal process. The letter will forward information regarding notifications to be published in the FEDERAL REGISTER and local newspaper(s) and will provide the first and second publication dates. The appeal period will start on the second publication date. Additional information concerning the 90-day appeal period will be provided during the CCO Meeting.

After the 30-day review and appeal periods have ended and we have addressed all comments/appeals, we will initiate final preparation of the FIRM panels and FIS report. The new FIRM panels and FIS report for your community will become effective approximately 9 to 11 months later. Before the effective date, you will be notified in writing of the official FIRM panels and FIS report effective date and asked to adopt floodplain ordinances or modify existing ordinances as necessary that correspond with the new FIRM panels or FIS report. If you or other community officials have any questions regarding floodplain

ordinances, you may raise them with our FEMA Region IX Natural Hazards Specialist, Cynthia McKenzie, either by telephone at (510) 627-7184 or by email at Cynthia.McKenzie@dhs.gov, or you may discuss those issues with your State NFIP Coordinator, Kim Davis, by telephone at (775) 684-2884 or by email at kadavis@water.nv.gov. At this stage in the flood map revision project, FEMA's contractor, BakerAECOM, has obtained all available data and produced Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panels for community review. In this fact sheet, we cover the next steps, including the comment process, community and public meetings, community adoption/compliance requirements, future map change options, and insurance implications.

Review and Comment Period

After the hydrologic and hydraulic analyses and mapping work was completed, your community received a preliminary version of the FIRM panels, Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report, and Summary of Map Actions (SOMA) listing all Letters of Map Change that FEMA issued for the flood map panels being revised. Your community officials will have 30 days to review this information and provide comments, such as changes or corrections to non-technical information (such as corporate limits or road names). Any comments that FEMA receives will be assessed and incorporated, as appropriate, into the FIRM panels and FIS report. During the 30-day review period, FEMA will contact the community to schedule a meeting with community officials to formally present the study results, respond to your comments and questions, and discuss the floodplain management and adoption/compliance requirements.

After the state and FEMA meet with community officials, currently scheduled for May 9, 2012 in the city of Battle Mountain, your community is encouraged to hold a public meeting to present the study results and Preliminary FIRM panels. This meeting gives interested parties an opportunity to view the changes to the flood map and ask questions about how the map changes will affect them.

Appeal Process

FEMA provides a 90-day appeal period when new or revised flood elevations are proposed and when any regulatory floodway or Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) boundary or zone designations are added or modified. Before the appeal period is initiated, FEMA will publish the proposed Flood Hazard Determination (FHD) in the Federal Register and notify your community's Chief Executive Officer of the determination. FEMA will then publish information about the proposed FHD in a local newspaper at least twice. To make these notices available to a broader audience, the newspaper notices will direct readers to FEMA's Web site. http://www.floodmaps.fema.gov/fhm/scripts /bfe_main.asp#1, which will contain a link to the Preliminary FIRM panels and FIS report available at http://www.r9map.org

The appeal period provides the community and owners or lessees of property in the community an opportunity to provide data or documentation indicating that the proposed FHDs are scientifically or technically incorrect. However, your community has the right, at any time, to submit scientific or technical data to improve the flood hazard information shown on the FIRM panels through the Letter of Map Change process. At the end of the 90-day appeal period, FEMA addresses all appeals and other comments and finalizes the FIRM panels and FIS report.

To support an appeal, the appellant should provide the justification for the new methodology or change in assumptions. Anyone can also appeal the FHDs if they are technically incorrect, which means there is an error in the analysis.

What Is an Appeal?

An appeal is a formal objection to the proposed new or revised flood elevations, the addition or modification of any Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) boundary or zone ... designation, and the addition or modification of any regulatory floodway. An individual or the .community.must.submit_ technical or scientific data to support an appeal. All appeals should be submitted through the community... What is a Comment?

Comments generally involve one of the following:

- Corporate limits
- Roads and road names

When FEMA receives an appeal, we suspend the processing of the FIRM until the appeal is resolved. If warranted, we will revise the Preliminary FIRM panels and FIS report. Under Part 67 of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) regulations, the required scientific and/or technical data to support an appeal must be submitted during the 90-day appeal period to receive consideration before the new FIRM panels and FIS report are published.

Map Adoption/Compliance Requirements

After all appeals and comments are addressed, FEMA will issue a Letter of Final Determination (LFD) for each affected community, which establishes the final flood elevations and provides the new FIRM panels and FIS report to each community. The LFD starts the six-month adoption and compliance period during which your community must adopt or amend its floodplain management regulations to reflect the changes in the FIRM panels and FIS report. Ordinances must meet or exceed 44 CFR 60.3 and be legally enforceable before the date the FIRM becomes effective.

The FIRM panels and FIS report become effective at the end of the six-month period. The effective date is also the date when flood insurance rates will be based on the new flood data.

In some cases, communities may have to adopt additional floodplain management requirements if a new type of flood hazard data is provided, such as a new flood zone or a floodway designation. Your State NFIP Coordinator may have a State Model Ordinance that you can use as the foundation for your ordinance.

Should your community fail to update its ordinance, it will be subject to suspension from the NFIP, which would make flood insurance and certain types of Federal disaster assistance unavailable within the community. Suspension of a participating community occurs automatically when community officials fail to adopt an updated ordinance within six months of the LFD that notified them of that requirement. It is your community's responsibility to notify FEMA Region IX once you have updated the ordinance. FEMA and your State NFIP Coordinator can work with you to update your ordinance and avoid suspension.

Map Change Options


In addition to the appeal process, community officials and citizens may submit scientific or technical data to improve the flood hazard information shown on the effective FIRM panels for their community at any time. FEMA established the Letter of Map Amendment and Letter of Map Revision Based on Fill processes for individual structures or lots, and the Letter of Map Revision process for more extensive changes. Detailed information on map revisions and amendments is provided in the Guide for Community Officials and on FEMA's Web site (see links in sidebar).

Flood Insurance Implications

If a property is mapped into a high-risk area (shown as a zone labeled with letters starting with "A" or "V") and the owner has a mortgage through a federally regulated or insured lender, flood insurance will be required when the FIRM panels become effective. Property owners who obtain flood insurance before the FIRM panels become effective and then maintain it may be able to benefit from the NFIP's "grandfathering" insurance rating process and pay a lower premium.

Everyone is at some risk from flooding—even those behind levees or in low- or medium-risk areas. Therefore, FEMA encourages everyone to purchase flood insurance. Property owners should contact their insurance agent or visit www.FloodSmart.gov for more information.



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Utah counties sue BLM over road dispute

SALT_LAKE CITY -- Ten Utah counties have sued the federal government over title to thousands of miles of dirt roads that cross public land in the state, and 12 more counties are expected to follow suit next week.

The state of Utah will be listed as a plaintiff in the lawsuits filed by 22 of Utah's 29 counties against the Interior Department and the Bureau of Land Management, said John Swallow, Utah's chief deputy attorney general.

Beaver, Box Elder, Carbon, Duchesne, Emery, Piute, Rich, Sanpete, Utah and Wayne counties had filed separate lawsuits in U.S. District Court in Salt Lake City as of Friday night.

The state of Utah is listed as a plaintiff in the complaints already filed, Swallow said, and expects to join the remaining 12 suits that should be filed Monday and Tuesday.

"We're trying to protect the roads that Utahns have used for decades," he said.

"If we don't file these lawsuits, we can't even protect the roads, and so the federal government can actually close down the roads and obliterate our rights to use those roads."

Gov. Gary Herbert in December issued notice of the state's intent to sue the federal government over access to more than 18,000 roads.

Representatives of the Southern Utah Wilderness Alliance and the Sierra Club have sharply criticized the suits, saying they could cost the state millions of dollars in legal fees and lost tourism revenue.

The groups also say the increased vehicle access would degrade important habitat for mule deer and sage grouse, and lead to more vandalism and theft at sensitive archaeological sites.

They have issued a map that shows the state is trying to claim management over more than 45,000 miles of roads that cross Utah's rugged backcountry, national parks and wilderness areas.

County and state officials argue access should be maintained on these roads because they are important routes for traveling in rural areas of the state and they provide access to the outdoors.

They also maintain the roads should be accessible because they were used for at least a decade before the federal government chose to close them.
