Loren made the motion to replace engine in mower. Larry 2nd the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

Sever weather was brought up again and how to alert campers. Addition of more alert system would help. Jeff made the motion to purchase 2 visual & audio alert sirens to install in the park. Loren 2nd the motion. All approved. Motion Carried.

Jim did share that there was an incident on the water involving an adult male. The ambulance was called and the adult male was transported to a local medical facility for medical treatment. The board thanked Jim and his staff for responding to the situation with great care and professionalism.

Electrical update. Jim will contact Labine Electric before the 4th weekend to hopefully remedy east end prior to long weekend.

Jim will put together a list of excess property to county so that we can get them off of park property.

Will look into repairing the paddle boats.

Kayak- Jeff made the motion to purchase another 2 seater kayak. Kristi 2nd the motion. All approved. Motion Carried.

Sheriff Boman joined the meeting. Addressed some of the concerns and how we can remedy them. We expressed our continued thanks for the Marshall County Sheriff's Department and their presence and keeping our park safe. Sheriff Boman mentioned he would also check into Stones radio system for the park (outdoor emergency siren system).

It has been decided that all campers & property will need to be removed by XX date.
