Welcome to Marshall County Park at Florian!

Please read over our Policy pages to see if Marshall County Park at Florian is the right place for your next camping get-away. When you register to camp with us, you have become one of our Guests.

- This property is owned and operated by Marshall County, a Park Board and on-site manager(s). We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who does not follow and respect our policies.
- Customers registering to rent a campsite must be 21 years or older.
- Check-out time: 2:00 p.m.
- Check-in time: 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Quiet Hours: 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- Loud parties are not allowed.
- Fireworks are not allowed within the park (per insurance company)
- Signed contracts are required for Seasonal and Monthly guests.
- All guests must show their vehicle pass in their windshield to the park office attendant upon entering the park. Seasonal passes must be affixed to the lower right corner of the windshield.
- All motorized vehicles must observe Marshall County Campground rules. Speed limit is 10 mph to protect the safety of everyone. There is a golf cart/ATV permit fee of \$5 for use in park.
- Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. Any minors must be under supervision of a parent or responsible adult after 10:00 p.m.
- Please respect fences, other campsites and adjacent property.
- We no longer will be providing garbage pickup service. Campers are welcome to use the dumpsters on the east side of the park entrance. Please keep our campgrounds and your campsite clean.

- Pet owners must be able to provide proof of rabies/distemper vaccination for all pets entering the park.
- All pets must be on a leash at all times. Pet leashes are prohibited from being secured around a tree.
- No pets allowed in the playground sand, sandy beach & beyond. You must pick up after your pets.
- Golf carts operate from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. and must operate on roads and grass only. You must be a licensed driver to operate a golf cart in the park.
- No Golf carts or motorized vehicles allowed on the bike trail except for the manager's golf cart or ATV when they are maintaining and monitoring the trail.
- ATVs must operate at a slow speed (10 mph) from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Drivers can drive only from their camper to the main gate. Note: you must be a licensed driver to operate on park property. **ATVs must also purchase a seasonal or daily park pass.**
- All air conditioners must be turned off when you are leaving the park overnight. Leaving air conditioners running will result in a notification by phone. If you fail to turn off the air conditioner following the phone call, you will be fined \$20/day.
- No swimming on or below the dam.
- No fishing from the swimming dock or beach.
- Blow-up or hard sided swimming pools or hot tubs are NOT permitted.
- Unreasonable noise will not be tolerated. 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. are quiet hours. Radios, stereos, TV's, Etc., will be operated in a manner that does not disturb others. Any disturbance should be reported to the park manager on duty.
- Park is open from May 1st weekend thru September 30. (Water is shutoff in September and turned on the second week of May, but is completely determined by the weather and temperatures)

R.V.s, Travel Trailers, Pop-Ups, & Tents:

- Your camping site may include hookups for water and electric.
- Each site comes with a picnic table and a fire ring.

- If you have music playing outside of your camper, on yourself while you are walking around the campground, or have an outdoor T.V. at your campsite, the volume levels need to be at a respectable level. If other campers are having issues with the volume level, you will be asked to turn it down or possibly turn it off.
- If you have an early morning departure, please hook up your rig the night before to help control the noise of cleaning up your camp site. Campground quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- All R.V.s must be motorized or have a vehicle capable of moving the R.V. when and if required.
- R.V.s must be insured and licensed.
- Certified firewood is available for purchase at the office.
- Prior permission must be given by management before washing your camper. No car/truck washing allowed.
- Signed contracts are required for Seasonal and Monthly guests.
- Seasonal Site maintenance, we take pride in our park, trimming is expected. If you are unavailable to maintain your site, site maintenance can be hired for a flat fee of \$15.00 per site per time. If you fail to comply and trim the long foliage **(6 inches in height)** around your camper and site, you will be charged \$25.00.
- The sale or exchange of title for a recreational vehicle, camper or motor home, does NOT include the transfer of the seasonal lot in Marshall County Park at Florian. You must contact the park to be added to the waiting list.

Visitors:

Welcome Visitors! If you are a visitor who is meeting up with one of our camping guests, here is the info you need to know:

- The beach does have a lifeguard on duty when the temperature is at or above 65 degrees Fahrenheit. When there is no lifeguard on duty you are swimming at your own risk. You must stay near the beach if your children are swimming in the water or are playing in the sand.
- Quiet Hours: 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Children 17 years old and under must be with their parents or guardian.
- This property is owned and operated by Marshall County, a Park Board and on-site managers. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who does not follow and respect our Policies. Those who do not follow policies will be asked to leave promptly.

Firewood:

- Please don't peel the bark off trees or cut up the trees for firewood.

- Fallen sticks already on the ground may be picked up and put in your fire pit.
- Firewood is available for purchase at the office.

Adult Beverages:

- Marshall County Park at Florian is a family-oriented place, we will not tolerate rowdiness that is a result of adult beverage consumption. If a verbal or written warning has been given to the rowdy individual, the next rowdiness incident will result in immediate dismissal from the property. If the individual persists, Marshall County Sheriff's Department will be contacted.
- We take pride in our campground being clean and environmentally friendly. There is a site to recycle aluminum cans by the enclosed shelter.
- No adult beverages are permitted in the sandy areas of the beach and or playgrounds.
- No adult beverages are permitted in the Park Office Building.

Recycling:

- We take pride in our campground being clean and environmentally friendly.
- If you see trash on the campground lawn, we ask that you help us pick it up and put it in the nearest garbage container.
- There is also a separate location for aluminum cans to be placed in. It is to the east of the park enclosed shelter.
- You will find trash dumpsters located by the enclosed shelter, east side of the park entrance.
- The brush pile is compostable materials only. No dumping or garbage is permitted.

Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellation four or more days prior to arrival: camping payment will be refunded.
- A cancellation less than four days prior to arrival: first night of camping fee is forfeited and customer will be refunded the remaining amount.
- Cancellation of no show: If a campsite is not occupied on the first night of a reservation, the reservation will be cancelled.
- If you are canceling a reservation, please call the park at 218-478-3658.

- No refunds due to weather or early departure; including violation of the rules. All violations of the rules shall be subject to immediate removal from the park areas with no refund.
