A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN MIDVALE CITY AND THE MOUNTAIN VIEW CHRISTIAN ASSEMBLY CHURCH OF THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING WATER FOR A COMMUNITY GARDEN

WHEREAS, Mountain View Christian Assembly Church is the owner of property located at approximately 8000 South 300 East upon which is being developed a community garden including individual garden plots, larger plots, larger acres for farming activities, placement of beehives and future fruit trees; and

WHEREAS, because of development of a new city hall and senior citizen projects, the previously existing community gardens are no longer existing and available; and

WHEREAS, The City has previously supported that community garden with limited water and other resources designed for the production of fresh produce; and


WHEREAS, the City has been requested by the Church to provide similar water and resources to the garden for a limited period of time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Midvale City that the Mayor be authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between Midvale City and the Mountain View Christian Assembly Church for the purposes of providing water for the Community Garden.
