RESOLUTION NO. 2014-R-27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIDVALE CITY AND UNIFIED FIRE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH RADIO FREQUENCIES OWNERSHIP, USE AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES AS DEFINED IN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS, Midvale City owns licenses for two 800MHz radio frequency pairs;

WHEREAS, the location of Midvale's current repeater does not provide full radio coverage for the city;

WHEREAS, Midvale City may require more than the two existing talk groups for events and during emergencies;

WHEREAS, Unified Fire Authority (UFA) currently provides and maintains an 800MHz trunked radio system for public safety and services;

WHEREAS, Unified Fire Authority has proposed to incorporate Midvale City's radio frequencies into their trunked radio system for increased capacity in exchange for ten talk groups and assume financial responsibility for the frequency licenses and equipment;

WHEREAS, Midvale City and UFA will both benefit from the increased capacity of the UFA trunked radio system;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Midvale City has entered into a memorandum of understanding agreement with Unified Fire Authority(UFA) to allow secondary ownership and use of the radio frequencies and to transfer associated radio repeater assets in exchange for use of ten talk channels on the UFA owned trunked radio system, and payment, by UFA, of the ongoing frequency license costs and maintenance as described in the Memorandum of Understanding.
