Resolution No. 2014-R-36

A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Mutual Aid Interlocal Agreement for Utah Public Works Emergency Management

Whereas, the Mutual Aid Interlocal Agreement (“Agreement”) for Utah Public Works Emergency Management is to provide a method whereby participating Public Works Agencies, which sustain damage from natural or man-made disasters can obtain emergency assistance, in the form of personnel, equipment, materials and other associated services; and


Whereas, the Agreement was created pursuant to an interlocal agreement with participating agencies intend to commit to assist to each other whenever possible; and

Whereas, the Agreement allows each participating agency the sole discretion to determine when its personnel and equipment cannot be spared for assisting other participating agencies; and

Whereas, the Agreement provides procedures for assistance and reimbursement of expenses, supports and compliments the Utah Mutual Aid Agreement (UAC R704-2), and establishes an effective term of 50 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MIDVALE CITY, UTAH:

1. The Midvale City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Mutual Aid Interlocal Agreement for Utah Public Works Emergency Management as outlined in the attached Agreement.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
