A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE TO SERVE ON THE TRANS-JORDAN LANDFILL BOARD

Whereas, the Trans-Jordan Cities Interlocal Agency is governed by a board of trustees of the seven member cities; and

Whereas, the representative of each City is appointed by the governing body of such city to serve as a member of the Board; and

Whereas, an alternative representative is also appointed to serve as a member of the Board in the absence or disability of the representative with the same voting privileges; and

Whereas, the City Council desires to appoint Kane Loader, City Administrator, to represent Midvale City on the Trans-Jordan Landfill Board; and

Whereas, the City Council desires to appoint Larry Wright, Public Works Director, as an alternate representative for Midvale City on the Trans-Jordan Landfill Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MIDVALE, UTAH:

Section 1. The City Council desires to appoint Kane Loader, City Administrator, as the representative on the Trans-Jordan Landfill Board, and Larry Wright, Public Works Director, as the alternate representative.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
