WHEREAS, Midvale City (City) applied for the Thrive 125 Community Celebration Grant (Grant) which provides funding for events that celebrate Utah’s statehood; and

WHEREAS, the City committed in the grant application to utilize grant funds for added activities to celebrate 125 years of Utah’s Statehood.



WHEREAS, the City and the CCE have prepared Grant Agreement (Agreement) for the administration of the grant; and

Utah Department of Cultural and Community Engagement Memorandum of Agreement

This agreement is entered into by the Utah Department of Cultural and Community Engagement, herein referred to as CCE, and City of Midvale

Purpose: This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) establishes the terms and scope of the agreement between the Utah Department of Cultural and Community Engagement (CCE) and **City of Midvale** in relation to the Thrive125 Community Celebration Grant. Funds will be used by Utah community and neighborhood organizations, local arts councils, historical societies, and municipalities to hold events, festivals, or programs celebrating 125 years of Utah Statehood.

Term of Agreement: The term of this agreement begins July 1, 2021, and will be maintained until December 31, 2021, of which disbursements are from State Fiscal Year 2022.

The amount payable to Organization by CCE for the performance of activities outlined in this Agreement shall not exceed **\$7500**, payable in one lump sum.

Terms and Conditions:

Organization must qualify as being tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; or a local municipality or government.



- a. Grant funds may only be used for the Community Event, Festival, or Program indicated in the application.
- b. Grant funds must be used for the expenses indicated in the grant application – any changes must be communicated in writing and approved by CCE **before** grant funds are spent (see j. below).
- c. Grant funds may not be used for cash prizes, physical prizes, or gift cards.
- d. Grant funds may not be used for fireworks.
- e. Organization agrees to report back to the CCE on the use of grant funds within 30 days after funds are fully expended. Reports will be accessible through the CCE Community Grants Portal. Organizations will be notified when the reporting framework is available.
- f. Final reports must be received by January 31, 2022.
- g. Grant funding must be fully expended by December 31, 2021.
- h. Events, Festivals, or Programs are expected to uphold the goals and vision of Thrive125.
- i. CCE is subject to the Government Records Access and Management Act, Utah Code § 63G-2-101 et seq. (“GRAMA”). Accordingly, certain records within possession or control, including without limitation, this Agreement, may be subject to public disclosure; and both parties’ confidentiality obligations shall be subject in all respects to compliance with GRAMA.
- j. This Agreement may only be amended by the mutual written agreement of the parties, which amendment will be attached to this Agreement.
