**A RESOLUTION NAMING THE MIDVALE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER  
AUDITORIUM THE “JOANN B. SEGHINI MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM”**

**WHEREAS**, JoAnn B. Seghini served three terms on the Midvale City Council, retired after 26 years in education, and ended her civic career having served as Midvale City Mayor from 1998 to 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, JoAnn B. Seghini’s passion was Midvale City, turning down other higher-profile political positions to stay in Midvale to make a difference; and

**WHEREAS**, JoAnn B. Seghini encouraged everyone to be a good neighbor, support the arts, support the schools, and work together for the betterment of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, JoAnn B. Seghini was a staunch supporter of the arts and providing quality entertainment at little or no charge to Midvale residents, particularly those in disadvantaged situations; and


