**A RESOLUTION OF MIDVALE CITY, AUTHORIZING SPECIFIC CITY
EMPLOYEES TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE CITY'S PUBLIC TREASURERS
INVESTMENT FUND (PTIF) ACCOUNT**

Whereas, The Utah Office of the State Treasurer manages the PTIF, a Fund available to State and local government entities as a short-term cash investment vehicle; and

Whereas, the Utah Office of the State Treasurer requires participating organizations to name by resolution the employees of the organization allowed access to the PTIF account; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the City to allow the City Treasurer; and

Whereas, it is reasonable and responsible to allow the Administrative Services Director to make changes to the Account as well,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MIDVALE, UTAH, that the City Treasurer, Karen Kester, and the Administrative Services Director, Mariah Hill, are authorized to add or delete users to access and/or transact with PTIF accounts; to add, delete, or make changes to bank accounts tied to PTIF accounts; to open or close PTIF accounts; and to execute any necessary forms in connection with such changes on behalf of Midvale City.


This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage thereof.
