

**MIDVALE CITY, UTAH
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-20**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE OF
MIDVALE CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT MAP**

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated Section 10-3-205.5 provides that the municipal legislative body, within six months following the Legislature completing its redistricting process, shall adjust the boundaries of the council districts as may be required to maintain districts of substantially equal population; and

WHEREAS, Midvale City Council adopted a map defining new district boundaries on April 19, 2022 as required by Section 10-3-205.5; and

WHEREAS, there is no state law, county, or city ordinance that requires an effective date for the district map establishing the new district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desired to establish an effective date for the newly adopted district map to clarify any confusion regarding district boundaries for the 2023 election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that the effective date for the newly adopted district map be January 2, 2023.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
MIDVALE, UTAH**

1. The effective date of the district map, adopted by Midvale City Council on April 19, 2022, shall be January 2, 2023.
2. This Resolution takes effect immediately.
