**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AMENDMENT #2 TO  
GRADE SEPARATED CROSSING AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIDVALE CITY AND  
UTAH TRANSIT AUTHORITY**

**WHEREAS**, Midvale City seeks to make sidewalk and other access improvements to the East sidewalk on Holden Street under the UTA tracks line,

**WHEREAS**, UTA has reviewed designs and proposed improvements and agrees to allow the improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, Midvale City agrees to the terms of Amendment #2 to the Grade Separated Crossing Agreement between Midvale City and Utah Transit Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, These improvements will provide safe sidewalks for residents and guests of Midvale City and will provide improved access to Holden Street and Main Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Midvale City agrees to the fees listed in the amendment.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, based on the foregoing, the Midvale City Council does hereby approve Amendment #2 to the Grade Separated Crossing Agreement between Midvale City and Utah Transit Authority and authorizes the Mayor to sign the same between Midvale City and Utah Transit Authority.
