WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of Midvale City (the "Agency") was created by the Midvale City Council to transact the business and exercise the powers provided for in the Utah Redevelopment Agencies Act; and

WHEREAS, the Agency created the Main Street Community Development Area (the "CDA") in 2015 to revitalize and improve the Main Street area; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2015, Midvale City (the "City") adopted the Main Street Community Development Area's Project Area Plan through Ordinance No. 2015-O-14 pursuant to UCA § 17C-4-105, and fulfilled all public hearing and noticing requirements associated with adopting a community development area plan outlined in UCA § 17C-4-401 and 17C-4-107; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of Midvale City ("Agency") revised and adopted a Main Street Community Development Area Budget through Resolution No. 2020-12RDA pursuant to UCA § 17C-4-204 and which Budget illustrates that SLCo will receive a net fiscal benefit and enjoy significant economic and social impacts, and

WHEREAS, the Salt Lake County Council ("SLCo") voted on February 1, 2022, and entered into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("ILA") with the Agency pursuant to UCA § 17C-4-201; and

WHEREAS, the Agency and SLCo wish to consider resolutions, in which the Agency and SLCo would approve certain amendments to the ILA pursuant to UCA § 17C-4-201(7)(a), which amendments would not induce any substantive changes to the Agreement but would improve the clarity and enforceability of the ILA and which are found in Exhibit A, Amendment No 1 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake County and the Redevelopment Agency of Midvale City; and

WHEREAS, the meeting in which this Resolution was considered by the Agency and in which SLCo's related Resolution will be considered are both conducted in open and public meetings pursuant to UCA § 17C-4-202; and

This Resolution shall become effective once approved by the Agency's Board of Directors.

AMENDMENT NO 1 TO THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN SALT LAKE COUNTY AND THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF MIDVALE CITY

Midvale Main Street CDA Project

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 (the "Amendment") is made to above-named Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (the "Agreement") between SALT LAKE COUNTY, a body corporate and politic of the State of Utah (the "County"), and THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF MIDVALE CITY, a public entity (the "Agency"). The County and the Agency may each be referred to herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Agreement whereby the County, as a taxing entity, consented to the Agency receiving certain Tax Increment to be created by development activities in the Project Area, to assist in development as set forth in the Project Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to specify the applicable Base Tax Year and the commencement of the County's Contribution payments.

AMENDMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby amend the Agreement as follows:

- Section 1(a) of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - (a) Payment Period. The initial payment of the County's Contribution will be made to the Agency from taxes collected during 2024 and will be paid to the Agency the following year. Such a payment shall be made annually thereafter until either of the following occurs: a) a total of twenty (20) annual payments have been made: or b) the total cumulative amount of the Agency's Share, defined below, reaches \$2.264.812 (the "Contribution Cap"). The period during which payments are made to the Agency under this section is referred to herein as the "Tax Increment Payment Period."
 - Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 3. Section 3 of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - 3. <u>Base Year and Base Taxable Value</u>. For purposes of calculating the annual Tax Increment, the "<u>Base Tax Year</u>" shall be 2022. "<u>Base Taxable Value</u>" equals the assessed taxable value of all Property within the Project Area for 2022.
- The document attached to the Agreement as Exhibit B is deleted in its entirety. The Agency affirms that the documents attached to the Agreement as Exhibits A and C remain true

and accurate representations of the Project Area Plan and the Project Budget, respectively, as of the date of this Amendment.

- All remaining provisions of the Agreement, not specifically altered by this Amendment, shall continue in full force and effect under this Amendment.
- 6. The date this Amendment is signed by the last Party to sign it (as indicated by the date stated under that Party's signature) will be deemed the date of this Amendment.
