**Ever wonder how a chick in an egg breathes?**

Under the egg's shell are two membranes. When an egg is laid it is very warm, as it cools the material inside the egg shrinks a little bit. The two membranes pull apart a little and create a small sack of air. As the chick grows, it breathes in oxygen from the air sack and exhales carbon dioxide. Several thousand microscopic pores all over the surface of the egg allow the CO2 to escape and fresh air to get in.  
So breathe easy, the Chick does.
