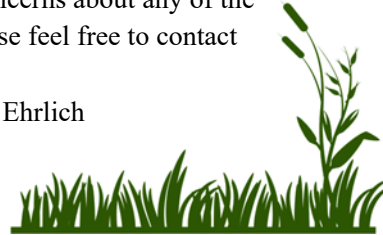
Please make sure your weeds do not grow more than 6 inches tall and keep the noxious weeds cleared away.

To Permit or Not to Permit??

Permit requirements for certain construction activities may seem obvious, such as new construction, garages, basement finishes and the like.

However, residents may be unaware of the Town's requirements for a fence permit. Fence permits are required for construction of a new fence or replacement of an existing fence in either or both the front or rear yard.

The good news is that fence permits are provided at no cost! If you are contemplating replacement, major repair or a new fence, please contact the Community Development Department and we will be happy to assist with your permit application and issuance process.
