Business License

Town of Milliken requires all businesses residing in or doing business with the Town to have a business license.

Doing business means an act of one (1) of the following:

- a. Selling at retail any goods or service;
- b. Soliciting or offering goods or services for retail sale or hire; or
- c. Acquiring or using any vehicle or any premises in the Town for business purposes.

For a business license application go to: www.millikenco.gov or come into Town Hall. There is a \$20 annual fee for a business license application.

SNOW REMOVAL—YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Milliken Police department would like to remind residents of ordinance : 11-1-20

Snow & ice removal from sidewalks. The owner, occupant, lessee or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property, and shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed or cleared away, snow and ice from sidewalks in all business districts within the Town by four (4) business hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain or by the beginning hours of the next business day following such fall, whichever period is shorter, and from all other sidewalks in the Town within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain.

Message from your Town Administrator

The Traffic light poles located on SH 60 at Alice St are up, however we have some power lines along SH 60 on the north side going over Alice that are too close a proximity to the traffic light arms for safety. CDOT and the contractor have completed about as much as they can until Xcel can get the power line moved and buried.

We've finally had a sit down with Xcel and they have promised to have the line buried by the middle of December. One of their concerns has to do with all the infrastructure in the ground at that intersection and the complexities with boring under Alice and not hitting anything. They are now planning on trenching the street in order to bury the lines.
