

According to the Milliken Municipal Code Article 1 Section 6.1, all businesses are required to obtain a Milliken business license.

*Doing business* means an act of one (1) of the following:

- a. Selling at retail any goods or service;
- b. Soliciting or offering goods or services for retail sale or hire; or
- c. Acquiring or using any vehicle or any premises in the Town for business purposes.

The Town is accepting applications until February 9, 2021.

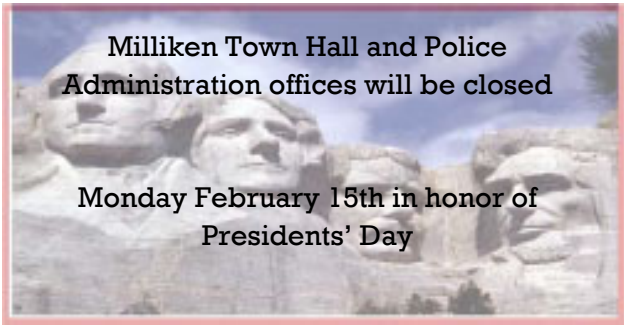

The Milliken Police Department has seen an influx of complaints regarding people walking on the ice at Centennial and Ehrlich lakes. There are several signs in place reminding people to stay off the ice, however, we are seeing more and more younger children on the ice. Therefore, we wanted to reiterate to the public about the dangers of being on the ice and making sure we remind others including children to **Stay Off The Ice**. There are currently running aerators on the lake to prevent fish kill, the steady movement of the water prevents the water from freezing and may amount to thinner ice. The safety of our community is important and the dangers of falling through the ice can be preventable, we need your help in reminding others including children to stay off the ice.

Dogs are required to be licensed annually with the Town of Milliken.

The cost is \$6 if spayed or neutered and \$10 if not.

Provide a copy of the current rabies certificate to Town Hall and fill out a short form. Your pet will receive a tag that will allow us to locate you if your pet were to get lost.
