Proposed Changes to Flood Hazard Determinations

The Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) along with consultant AECOM have been completing hydrologic studies of the changes in river channels caused by the floods of 2013. The rivers in and around Milliken included in these studies are the Big Thompson, Little Thompson and South Platte rivers. The results of these studies have been sent to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for proposed changes to flood hazard determinations for properties along these rivers, and to update the Flood Insurance Rate Maps for areas of Weld County including Milliken.

Affected property owners received a letter in early September of 2020 with dates, times and locations of open houses being conducted to explain and answer questions about the remapping project. The project is now in the APPEAL phase where the public has an opportunity to appeal the flood changes proposed by the studies.
