Town of Milliken Requires a Business License



All businesses residing in or doing business in the Town of Milliken are required to have a business license.

Doing business means an act of one (1) of the following:

- a. Selling at retail any goods or service;
- b. Soliciting or offering goods or services for retail sale or hire; or
- c. Acquiring or using any vehicle or any premises in the Town for business purposes. For a business license application go to: www.millikenco.gov or come into Town Hall. There is a \$20 annual fee for a business license. For more information see Chapter 6 Article I of the Milliken Municipal Code.
