Did You Know:

The celebration of Halloween in America didn't take off until waves of immigrants from Ireland and Scotland arrived in the mid-1800s. They both carved faces on potatoes and turnips, and placed a candle inside. This was said to ward off spirits.



Pumpkins are native to North America, so while it's not known exactly when the first pumpkin was carved and lit, the first mention of pumpkin jack o'lanterns comes at around the same time. (1840's)

By the 1920s, Halloween had been embraced throughout the United States. Parties and costumes became the norm, and "trick or treating" soon followed in the mid-1930s.

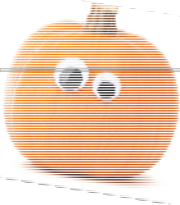
