

ORDINANCE NO. 798

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, COLORADO, SETTING THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE MAYOR FOLLOWING THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Town of Milliken is a statutory town existing pursuant to the provisions of the Colorado Constitution;

WHEREAS, section 31-4-301(4) of the Colorado Revised Statutes requires compensation of the Mayor and other members of the Board of Trustees (“Board”) to be fixed by ordinance;

WHEREAS, the compensation for the Mayor and the other members of the Board has not been updated since 2003;

WHEREAS, section 2-2-50(d) of the Milliken Municipal Code (“Code”) states that the “compensation paid to any member of the Board of Trustees, including the Mayor, shall not be increased or diminished for the term of office for which he or she has been elected or appointed;”

WHEREAS the Board desires to adjust the amount of compensation to be paid to the Mayor and other members of the Board following the next regular election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-2-50 of the Milliken Municipal Code is amended by the addition of the following new subsection (e):

- (e) Members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Milliken who are sworn in subsequent to, the election of April 5, 2022, shall be paid the compensation described in this section 2-2-50(e), which shall be noted in the Fee Schedule of the Town.
 - (1) The Mayor shall receive \$300 for each meeting and other members of the Board of Trustees shall receive \$150 for each meeting.
 - (2) A meeting is defined as any regularly scheduled meeting pursuant to section 2-2-60 of the Milliken Municipal Code, any special meeting pursuant to section 2-2-70 at which action is taken by the Board of Trustees, and any special meeting convened pursuant to a request of an interested party for the purposes of accommodating time constraints of said interested party.
 - (3) Work sessions held in advance of regularly scheduled meetings do not constitute separate meetings.
 - (4) Attendance by Board members at seminars, conferences and public meetings is not compensable since these are not considered meetings at which any action can be taken.


(5) In the event there are more than three meetings per month, the Mayor and Board members shall receive compensation for only three of those meetings.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after publication as provided by law.

Section 3. Prior Conflicting Ordinances. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.
