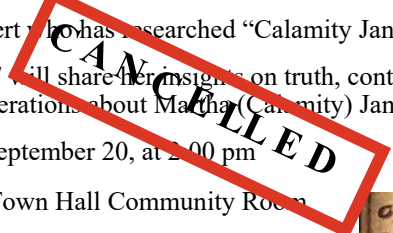

The Milliken Police Department has received several calls about solicitors. All solicitors soliciting in the Town of Milliken must register with the Town to receive a permit prior to going door to door.

You as a Milliken resident, have the right to request to see the permit from a solicitor, if they refuse to show you, it may be that they are soliciting illegally without a permit.

The soliciting ordinance was enacted to keep our citizens safe from scammers going door to door, therefore are required to go through the proper registration process. If at anytime you feel that you have been contacted by a solicitor without a license please contact the Milliken Police Department at (970) 587-2772.
