

RESOLUTION NO. 23-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, COLORADO, SCHEDULING A HEARING ON A PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2020 EDITION OF NFPA 70, THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, AND APPROVING THE NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED

WHEREAS article 16 of title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes Colorado municipalities to adopt codes by reference in whole or in part;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees ("Board") has been presented with a proposed ordinance adopting by reference the 2020 Edition of NFPA 70, the National Electrical Code ("NEC"); and

WHEREAS the Board desires to schedule a public hearing on the proposed ordinance and to approve the form of notice to be published of such hearing;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. A public hearing before the Town of Milliken Board of Trustees is hereby scheduled to be held at 6:30 PM on the 28th day of June, 2023, in the public meeting room at the Milliken Police Department building at 1201 Broad Street in the Town of Milliken for the purpose of considering the adoption by reference of the 2020 Edition of NFPA 70, the National Electrical Code.
2. The form of notice of the public hearing attached as Exhibit A to this resolution ("Notice") is approved for publication in accordance with statutory requirements.
3. The Board deems sufficient to give notice to interested persons the description in the Notice of the purpose of the primary code, the subject matter of the code, the name and address of the agency by which it has been promulgated, and the date of publication of such code.

**NOTICE OF HEARING
TOWN OF MILLIKEN**

NOTICE is hereby given of a public hearing to be held by and before the Board of Trustees of the Town of Milliken, Colorado, on the 28th day of June, 2023, in the public meeting room at the Milliken Police Department building at 1201 Broad Street in the Town of Milliken for the purpose of considering the adoption by reference of the 2020 Edition of NFPA 70, the National Electrical Code, (“NEC”) as the electrical ordinance/code of the Town of Milliken, Colorado. The hearing shall commence at 6:30 PM or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

Copies of the NEC and secondary codes described therein, if any, are on file at the office of the Town Clerk and may be inspected during regular business hours. If enacted as an ordinance of this Town the NEC will not be published in full, but in accordance with state law, copies will be kept on file.

The 2020 Edition of the NEC was published by the National Fire Protection Association, 1 Batterymarch Park, Quincy, MA 02169-7471, on August 25, 2019.

The subject matter of the NEC is as follows: According to section 90.2(A) of the NEC, the Code “covers the installation and removal of electrical conductors, equipment, and raceways; signaling and communications conductors, equipment, and raceways; and optical fiber cables” for a wide variety of premises and installations.

The purpose of the Ordinance and the Code adopted therein is as follows: According to section 90.1(A) of the NEC, “The purpose of this Code is the practical safeguarding of persons and property from hazards arising from the use of electricity.”
