Residents Who Received Vaccine Out of State Encouraged to Update MCHD

Monroe, MI, May 5, 2021-The Monroe County Health Department (MCHD) is encouraging any Monroe County resident who received one or both of their COVID-19 vaccines in a state other than Michigan to visit the MCHD so that information can be entered in the State of Michigan's Immunization Registry.

This can be accomplished by visiting the MCHD Monday through Friday, 8:30 A.M.-4:30 P.M. (excluding holidays), parking on the north (S. Custer Road) side of the building (near the flag pole), entering the vestibule and calling the number posted on the interior door upon arrival. An MCHD staff person will meet you at the door with the applicable paperwork for completion. Please be sure to bring your COVID-19 vaccine card with you to the MCHD.

The benefits of this are twofold: First, the vaccine is now recorded in the State database and on your personal healthcare record. Secondly, this information will be added to the County and State totals of the number of vaccinated individuals.
