intend to build a single, or two family, or nonresidential dwelling and understand and agree to the following conditions regarding the installation and maintenance of an engineered alternative onsite sewage disposal system at the above-described property in accordance with the Monroe County Sanitary Code.

- 1) *The owner is fully aware that the soil conditions on said parcel are not conducive for the proper operation of a conventional onsite sewage disposal system;*
- 2) *The owner will not split or subdivide the above-described parcel from its present size;*
- 3) *The owner agrees that the onsite sewage disposal system will be operated and maintained in a manner so as to not create a nuisance or health hazard in compliance with the Monroe County Sanitary Code;*
- 4) *The owner agrees the dwelling will be connected to an approved public wastewater collection system when available;*
- 5) *The person (owner) understands and acknowledges that the County of Monroe and the Monroe County Health Department assumes no responsibility or liability in granting of a permit to construct an engineered or alternative onsite sewage disposal system and, therefore, the owner agrees to hold harmless the County of Monroe as well as the Monroe County Health Department and its employees and agents from any and all liability, loss, and/or damages arising from the potential failure of said system.*
- 6) *The owner agrees to advise all prospective buyers of this Affidavit by including it as part of any Sales Agreement for the above-described property.*
- 7) *The owner is fully aware that for all mechanical systems for sewage treatment exclusive of conventional septic tanks and/or dosing tanks, evidence shall be presented of a satisfactory contract for continuing maintenance for a period of time as approved by the Monroe County Health Officer by a qualified service company authorized to do business in Michigan.*

The owner understands that failure to comply with the above agreement may result in the condemnation of the dwelling as unfit for human habitation or occupancy and subject to legal action as provided for in the Monroe County Sanitary Code.

This Affidavit becomes void upon connection to an approved public wastewater disposal system.
