SECURITY POLICY FOR COURT FACILITIES

This administrative order is issued in accordance with Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2001-1. The purpose of this order is to address the presence of weapons in court facilities.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. No weapons are allowed in the courthouse. This prohibition does not apply to court security personnel in the performance of their official duties or to Law Enforcement Officers who are in uniform, on official business, or transporting prisoners. Law Enforcement Officers on their own personal business must NOT be armed. The Chief Judge of each Court may authorize in writing additional exceptions in extraordinary circumstances.

2. All persons and their belongings (unless specifically excepted) and all parcels are subject to screening by Law Enforcement Officers, Court Officers, Bailiffs, and Security Personnel for the purpose of keeping weapons from entering the facility.

If at any time there is an articulable and reasonable suspicion that a weapon may be found, a person or object is subject to search. The search shall be no more intrusive than necessary to protect against the dangers presented.

3. Notice shall be posted that "No weapons are permitted in this Courthouse. All persons and parcels are subject to a search for weapons and restricted items as a condition of entry. Persons in violation of this order may be held in contempt of court, and are subject to imprisonment in the County Jail."
