**ORDER GRANTING A RESTRICTED TEXAS OPERATOR'S LICENSE**

On this day, a day in the regular term of this Court, came on to be considered Petitioner's Petition for Operator's License. This Court finds Petitioner has an essential and actual need for operating a motor vehicle for those reasons as specified herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Texas Department of Public Safety shall issue to \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner") an occupational license referring on its face to this Order. Petitioner is hereby granted the privilege of operating a motor vehicle with the following restrictions allowing Petitioner to drive for only those reasons as specified below as well as to complete any obligations of community supervision; to complete any conditions of bond; and to complete any task required by this Order for the period during which Petitioner's license has been suspended. Petitioner may also:

**Operate** a motor vehicle in the performance of an occupation or trade or for transportation to and from the place at which Petitioner practices said occupation or trade.

**Operate** a motor vehicle for transportation to and from an educational facility.

**Operate** a motor vehicle in the performance of essential household duties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Petitioner may drive in only the following Counties in the State of Texas: MONTGOMERY

**This Court** finds Petitioner has a necessity for waiver of the four hour operating period, therefore; IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the four (4) hour operating privilege is waived, and Petitioner may drive only during the following hours:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall attend alcohol group counseling or alcohol individual counseling once weekly for \_\_\_\_\_ weeks, with the first week beginning the first Monday after the date of this Order, at the location indicated as follows (Petitioner shall initial one provider):

\_\_\_\_\_ Prevail Counseling & Forensic Mental Health Consulting, PC, located 3421 West Davis, Suite 220, Conroe, TX 77304 (936-443-9629).

**This Court** finds that Petitioner has a DWI conviction within ten years of this suspension. **This Order** is VOID if the vehicle operated by Petitioner does not have an interlock device installed or the installed interlock device is not operational. Therefore, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall only operate vehicles equipped with an operational interlock that shall be installed by the second Monday after the date of this Order by the provider indicated as follows (Petitioner shall initial one provider):

**This Court** finds that Petitioner has a prior license suspension or prior DWI conviction during the five years preceding the date of the arrest of Petitioner; therefore this Order shall not take effect before the \_\_\_\_\_ day after the effective date of the license suspension in effect on the date this Order is signed.

**This Order** shall take effect immediately, and Petitioner may use a copy of this Court Order as an occupational Texas driver's license for 45 days after the date this Order is signed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner maintain a valid policy of automobile liability insurance in accordance with the provisions of applicable Texas law for the period during which Petitioner's license has been suspended, and that Petitioner shall carry a certified copy of this Order at all times while operating a motor vehicle. Failure of Petitioner comply with this Order will result in this license being revoked without further notice.
