ORDER GRANTING A RESTRICTED TEXAS OPERATOR'S LICENSE

On this day, a day in the regular term of this Court, came on to be considered Petitioner's Petition for Operator's License. The Court finds that the applicant's license has been suspended following a conviction for an offense under Sections 49.04-49.08, and the applicant has been restricted to the operation of a motor vehicle equipped with an ignition interlock device.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Texas Department of Public Safety shall issue to _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner") an occupational license referring on its face to this Order.

This Order is VOID if the vehicle operated by Petitioner does not have an interlock device installed or the installed interlock device is not operational. Therefore, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall only operate vehicles equipped with an operational interlock installed by the provider indicated as follows:

The occupational license granted herein is subject to immediate revocation upon notice to the court of a failed interlock report. It is further ordered that Petitioner shall submit to supervision by the local community supervision and corrections department to verify compliance with all terms of this order, and pay a monthly administrative fee, as authorized by Government Code Sec. 76.05.

This Order shall take effect immediately, and Petitioner may use a copy of this Court Order as an occupational Texas driver's license for 45 days after the date this Order is signed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner maintain a valid policy of automobile liability insurance in accordance with the provisions of applicable Texas law for the period during which Petitioner's license has been suspended, and that Petitioner shall carry a certified copy of this Order at all times while operating a motor vehicle. Failure of Petitioner comply with this Order will result in this license being revoked without further notice.
