AGENDA ITEMS 7A –Ratification of local disaster declaration was not discussed in court.

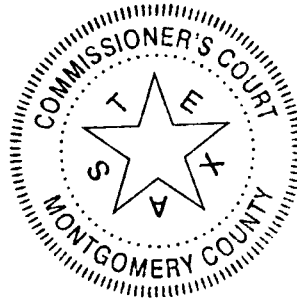
AGENDA ITEMS 7B – Action related to the immigration crisis at the border was not discussed in court.
