Eric Yollick addressed the court concerning the budget. He stated he had a few concerns including: the budget process; the County Auditor being involved in the meeting and county processes; and stated despite his criticalness of Commissioner Riley that he believed the County would be better off with Commissioner Riley on the court rather than a Democrat. He would like the tax rate to be lower than 0.4667 per \$100.00 valuation and stated that the only hope for that in the future is for Commissioner Riley and not a Democrat to be on the court.

Judge Doyal clarified the language that must be read when more revenue is generated.

Commissioner Noack addressed the 20% homestead and asked the citizens to imagine what their tax bill would look like if all the taxing entities followed suit and offered a 20% homestead exemption.

Mark Frank asked the court what is being done to get the other entities on board with the exemption.
