ORDER GRANTING A RESTRICTED TEXAS OPERATOR'S LICENSE

On this day, a day in the regular term of this Court, came on to be considered Petitioner's Petition for Operator's License. This Court finds Petitioner has an essential and actual need for operating a motor vehicle.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Texas Department of Public Safety shall issue to _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner") an occupational license referring on its face to this Order. Petitioner is hereby granted the privilege of operating a motor vehicle with the following restrictions

The Court finds, pursuant to the Texas Transportation Code § 521.248(d) that while this order is in effect, Petitioner is allowed to operate a motor vehicle equipped with an ignition interlock device for any purpose, in all Texas counties and at all times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall attend alcohol group counseling or alcohol individual counseling once weekly for _____ weeks, with the first week beginning the first Monday after the date of this Order, at the location indicated as follows (Petitioner shall initial one provider):

- _____ Mental Health Resource Center, located at 1915 N. Frazier #102, Conroe, TX 77301 (936-494-4357); 17892 N. Hwy. 59, New Caney, TX 77357; & 10601 Grant Rd, Houston, TX 77070.
- _____ Conroe Alcohol/Drug Services, located at 535-F South Frazier (P.O. Box 1217) Conroe, TX 77305 (936-539-4558);
- _____ Prevail Counseling & Forensic Mental Health Consulting, PC, located 3421 West Davis, Suite 220, Conroe, TX 77304 (936-443-9629).

This Order is VOID if the vehicle operated by Petitioner does not have an interlock device installed or the installed interlock device is not operational. Therefore, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall only operate vehicles equipped with an operational interlock that shall be installed by the second Monday after the date of this Order by the provider indicated as follows (Petitioner shall initial one provider):

- _____ Smart Start (800-880-3394 or 936-494-2006): CONROE
- _____ Draeger (281-651-1756) SOUTH MONTGOMERY COUNTY

The occupational license granted herein is subject to immediate revocation upon notice to the court of a failed interlock report.

It is further ordered that Petitioner shall submit to supervision by the local community supervision and corrections department to verify compliance with all terms of this order, and pay a monthly administrative fee, as authorized by Government Code Sec. 76.05.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner maintain a valid policy of automobile liability insurance in accordance with the provisions of applicable Texas law for the period during which Petitioner's license has been suspended, and that Petitioner shall carry a certified copy of this Order at all times while operating a motor vehicle. Failure of Petitioner comply with this Order will result in this license being revoked without further notice.

This Court finds that Petitioner has a prior license suspension or prior DWI conviction during the five years preceding the date of the arrest of Petitioner; therefore this Order shall not take effect before the _____ day after the effective date of the license suspension in effect on the date this Order is signed.

This Order shall take effect immediately, and Petitioner may use a copy of this Court Order as an occupational Texas driver's license for 45 days after the date this Order is signed.
