The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 19, 2010 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile, presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the October 5, 2010 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Presentations: 1) Tennessee Recreation Parks Association Awards; 2) National Guard Employer Support Award; and 3) East Tennessee Preservation Alliance Program Award.

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3393.09. Councilmember Jinks made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on second and final reading. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to award the Construction Contract Bid for the 2010-11 Annual Street Maintenance Program to APAC in the amount of \$152,867.50. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Dick Jessee, City Attorney, stated that the Mr. Sawyer published the ad for a public hearing on the proposed landfill at Lowland under the City Administrator's name. Some specific items that are mandatory for the ad were omitted from the previous ad run by Mr. Sawyer. Mr. Jessee recommended doing the procedure properly. Mr. Jessee will prepare the notice for the newspaper to start the process. If Mr. Sawyer has any additional information for the ad, it will be incorporated. If there is a request for a public hearing on the matter; a second notice will be published.

Councilmember Rooney made a motion to approve an on-premise beer permit for Tops China Buffet, located at 1336 W. Andrew Johnson Highway. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Mayor Barile adjourned the October 19, 2010 City Council meeting.
