

**STATE OF TENNESSEE

CORPORATION OF MORRISTOWN
JANUARY 18, 2011**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 18, 2011 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile, presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the January 4, 2011, minutes as circulated; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to award the bid for a photographer for Team Picture Rights to Chuck Hale Fotographic - Option 2 – 38%. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Anthony Cox, City Administrator, advised City Council of the following budget appropriation line item transfers:

August 10, 2010 - Transfer of \$4,257 from Patrol & Traffic 110-42120-111 (wages & salaries) to 110-42120-949 (other machinery & equipment).

December 10, 2010 - Transfer of \$1,158 from Narcotics 126-42170-390 (other supplies) to 126-42170-947 (office equipment).

December 21, 2010 - Transfer of \$2,400 from Human Resources 110-41650-390 (other supplies) to 110-41650-947 (office equipment).

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to open the agenda and add an amendment to a contract with Lamar Dunn & Associates which was approved at the January 4, 2011 Council meeting. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the amended contract (change in format – not contents) with Lamar Dunn & Associates (original contract approved at the January 4, 2011 Council meeting). Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers Garrett, Jinks, McGuffin, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmember Brooks "passed".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to accept Chief Overholt's recommendation and hire Michael Voccola, Jr. as an entry-level patrol officer. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted 'aye'.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to accept Chief Overholt's recommendation and hire George Ward as an entry-level patrol officer. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted 'aye'.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to accept Chief Overholt's recommendation and hire James Cruvey as an entry-level patrol officer. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted 'aye'.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to accept Chief Overholt's recommendation and hire Robert Reed as an entry-level patrol officer. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted 'aye'.

CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AS THE BEER BOARD.

Beer Board Sanctions against the following establishments:

- 1) El Portal Restaurant, 1147 South Cumberland – Violation of Beer Ordinance Section 8-209(4) **employee serving without a permit.**

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to revoke the beer license; Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion. Upon the advice of Dick Jessee, City Attorney, Councilmembers Jinks and Rooney withdrew their motion/second to revoke the license. Councilmember Jinks made a motion to impose a one hundred eighty (180) day suspension or in-lieu of civil penalty in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

- 2) Los Jarochos Restaurant, 1524 Buffalo Trail – Violation of Beer Ordinance Section 8-209(2)(a) **minimum seating requirements.**

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension or in-lieu of civil penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, Councilmembers McGuffin, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "no"; Councilmember Jinks voted "aye"; Councilmembers Brooks and Garrett "passed". **Failed to pass.**

Councilmember Brooks made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension or in-lieu of civil penalty in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon

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roll call, Councilmembers Brooks, Garrett, McGuffin, Rooney, Senter and Mayor Barile voted "aye"; Councilmember Jinks voted "no".

Mayor Barile adjourned the January 18, 2011 City Council meeting.
