The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 1, 2011 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile, presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Gene Brooks, Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the January 18, 2011 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to award the contract for the Public Works Slope Stabilization Project at the Liberty Hill Road Facility to Trent Excavating in an amount not to exceed \$32,520. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Chief Overholt requested that the bid for Soft Body Armor (ballistic vests) be deferred until a later date.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the following Ordinance 3393.12 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for February 15, 2010. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

A public input meeting on the policy for signs in the rights-of-way was scheduled for February 15, 2011, between the regular Council Meeting and the Work Session.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to reappoint Arnold Bunch to the Joint Hamblen Co/Morristown Solid Waste Disposal System Authority for a three year term to expire January 1, 2014. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".
