The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 15, 2011 with Honorable Mayor Barbara C. "Sami" Barile, presiding and the following named Councilmembers present: Bob Garrett, Claude Jinks, Frank McGuffin, William Rooney and Kay Senter; absent: Councilmember Gene Brooks.

Councilmember Jinks made a motion to approve the February 1, 2011 minutes as circulated; Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and all voted "aye".

A public hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3393.12. Councilmember Senter made a motion to adopt said Ordinance on second and final reading. Councilmember McGuffin seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to renew the annual Munis Maintenance Contract with Tyler Technologies in the amount of \$29,372.70. Councilmember Rooney seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to purchase a 250 gallon tote for application of mosquito spray from Clarke Chemical Company in the amount of \$10,932.77. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".

Councilmember McGuffin made a motion to approve the following captioned Ordinance No. 3409 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for March 1, 2011. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call, all voted "aye".
