The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 3, 2012 with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas presiding and the following Councilmembers present: Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Claude Jinks, Paul LeBel and Gene Brooks.

John Freitag, Senior Morristown Police Department Chaplain and retired Pastor of Our Savior Lutheran Church lead in the invocation and Councilmember Jinks led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the June 19, 2012 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3419.16.

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3419.16 on second and final reading. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3419.16**

**An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3419, The City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 and Appropriate the Sum of \$125,000 for Fire and Park & Rec for Accounts Over Budget.**

A Public Hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3445.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3445 on second and final reading. Councilmember Brooks seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3445**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. {Rezoning of property located at 490 Croxdale Road (Hamblen County Tax Map 42, Parcel 82.03) from Medium Density Residential (R-2) to Agriculture (A-1)}.**

A Public Hearing was held on the following captioned Ordinance No. 3446.

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3446 on second and final reading. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3446**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. {Rezoning of property located at 606 North Cumberland Street and 105 & 111 East 5th North Street (Hamblen County Tax Map 341, Group A, Parcels 37, 38 & 39) from Medium Density Residential (R2) to Local Business (LB)}.**

A Public Hearing was held on the amended and following captioned Ordinance No. 3447. The following people spoke regarding Ordinance No. 3447: Betsy Stibler.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the amended Ordinance No. 3447 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3447**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Title 14, Chapter 2 – Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 9 (LB) in its entirety; and Substituting in Lieu thereof the Following Replacing the LB – Local Business District.**

Councilmember Senter made a motion to award a bid for new 8” Gravity Sewer Extension Andrew Johnson Highway and Old Russellville Pike, abandon Joe Carter Pump Station Project, to M.G. Hall in the amount of \$60,055. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to award demolition bids to Bewley Excavation for demolition of 1205 West 5<sup>th</sup> North Street in the amount of \$4,300 and All Star Construction & Demolition for demolition of 425 Hedrick Street in the amount of \$2,996.13. Councilmember Jinks seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to award contract for Professional Airport Services to LPA Group with an amount not to exceed \$39,345 for the New Fueling Facility and amount not to exceed \$110,731 for the Terminal Area Aircraft Apron Expansion. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to reject the Mayors nomination of Tom Strate to the Morristown Utility Commission. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; Councilmembers Garrett, Bivens, Senter, Jinks and LeBel voted “aye”; Councilmember Brooks and Mayor Thomas voted “no”.

Mayor Thomas adjourned the July 3, 2012 meeting.
