APRIL 16, 2013**

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 16, 2013 with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas presiding and the following Councilmembers present: Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gene Brooks.

John Freitag, Senior Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Brooks led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the April 2, 2013 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Thomas presented a proclamation to the Tree Board recognizing April 26, 2013 as Arbor Day.

A Public Hearing was held on Ordinance No. 3467.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3467 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

An Ordinance Amending Title 13 Chapter 3 of the Morristown Municipal Code, Tree Ordinance.

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3468 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for May 7, 2013. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Brooks made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3470 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for May 7, 2013. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

(Annexation of property located at 2636 Shield's Ferry Road {HCTM 25, Parcel 1}, 2654 Shield's Ferry Road {HCTM 25, Parcel 2.01} and 2660 Shield's Ferry Road {HCTM 25, Parcel 4} 2536 Lakeview Drive {HCTM 25, Parcel 2} and 2540 Lakeview Drive {HCTM 25A, Group A Parcel 4} with the Zoning Designation of Agriculture (A-1) and Medium Density Residential (R-2).)**

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3471 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for May 7, 2013. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3471

An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. Rezoning of 505 & 515 Fairmont Ave. from Single Family Residential (R-1) to Office, Medical & Professional (OMP).

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve a change order to the North Fairmont Avenue Project for Storm Drainage Maintenance Program to M.G. Hall, LLC for the total amount of \$69,333 at the following locations and projects: North side of Meadowview Lane between 1711 & 1721; West side of Holston Valley & Memorial Avenue intersection; South side of Ozark beginning at 2324; Beginning at the end of cul-de-sac; McGhee Avenue north of the intersection of Maple; Beginning at the north side of Hugh Drive. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the TDOT Grant Amendment for Installation of Fueling System at the Airport with an increase per amendment of

\$211,104. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to re-appoint Robert T. Russell, Jim Clark and Joseph Wigington to the Construction Board of Adjustments, Appeals, and Examiners for a three (3) year term to expire May 1, 2016. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve a letter of request to Passover the lowest rated structure for the TDOT Bridge Grant Project Application to repair the bridge located at West 2nd North over Turkey Creek. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

City Administrator Tony Cox advised Council of the following budget appropriate line item transfers:

- Transfer of \$5,000 from Patrol & Traffic 110-42120-383 (Education, Seminars) to 110-42120-383 (Travel).

Mayor Thomas adjourned the April 16, 2013 meeting.
