The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 4, 2013 with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Mike Cutshaw, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the May 21, 2013 minutes as circulated. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to table Ordinance No. 3475, prior to the public hearing on said ordinance, for further discussion. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; Councilmembers Garrett, Bivens, Senter, Alvis, LeBel and Chesney voted "aye"; Mayor Thomas voted "no". Ordinance No. 3475 Tabled.

An Ordinance of the City of Morristown, Tennessee to Amend Section 8-207(1) of the Morristown Municipal Code [Permit required for engaging in beer business].

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3476 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 18, 2013. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3476

An Ordinance Establishing Expenditure Appropriations for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2013 and Ending June 30, 2014 and Further Approving the City Administrator's Proposed Budget with Such Modifications as Deemed Necessary or Desirable by the Morristown Tennessee City Council for the Fiscal Year 2013/2014.

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3477 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 18, 2013. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3477

An Ordinance to Fix the Rate for Ad Valorem Real and Personal Property Tax for the Tax Year of 2013.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve final change order to Performance Contracting Inc., for the Wastewater System Rehabilitation Program, Spring Creek Sewer Basin Gravity Sewer Line Closed-Circuit Inspection and Cleaning Project. This change order decreases the contract by \$70,053.93. Contract price prior to change order \$595,818.01; contract price with all approved Change Orders \$525,764.08. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve final change order to Portland Utilities Construction, LLC for the South High Street Sanitary Project. This change order decreases the contract by \$12,353.88. Contract price prior to change order \$145,132.09; contract price with all approved Change Orders \$132,778.21. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Vantage View Flood Contract Grant Application for participation in the Hazard Mitigation Program (HMGP) that the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency (TEMA) administers. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the on-premise beer permit for Los Caporales, (registered agent Marta Angelita Vargas), DBA Los Caporales, 1524 Buffalo Trail. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the on-premise beer permit for Asian 1 Restaurant (registered agent Shi Hui Gong), DBA Asian 1 Restaurant, 216 North Fairmont Ave. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Thomas adjourned the June 4, 2013 meeting.
