The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 21, 2017, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Ken Smith and Tommy Pedigo.

Charles Mills, Chaplain, Morristown Police Department, led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve the February 7, 2017, minutes as circulated. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Ordinance No. 3555.04. The following people spoke: Nigel Reid.

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3555.04 on second and final reading. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3555.04**

**To Amend Ordinance Number 3555, the City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 and to Appropriate an Additional Sum of \$68,286 Specifically for Grant Funds Received for the Police Department for the Purchase of Equipment, Lawsuit Settlement Proceeds and the Appropriation in Accordance with an Existing Contract, and the Reclassification of Appropriations for the Payment of Closing Costs on Bond issue.**

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3555.05 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said ordinance for March 7, 2017. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3555.05**

**To Amend Ordinance Number 3555, the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2016-2017, and to re-allocate funds that had been previously appropriated for other purposes; funds are being re-allocated to provide sufficient appropriations for equipment items in various departments.**

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the Uniform Bid for Parks & Recreation Department and Public Works Department to Access Solutions. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the Bucket Truck Bid for the Public Works Department to Altec in the amount of \$120,298. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".



Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the Inspection and Maintenance Agreement (I&M) between City of Morristown and East Main Storage. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Chesney appointed K.C. Culberson-Alvarado to the Morristown Regional Planning Commission for the remaining term of Doug Beier, who resigned, term to expire March 1, 2019.
