The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 2, 2017, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, and Tommy Pedigo, absent; Bob Garrett and Ken Smith.

Don Lamb, Chaplain, Morristown Fire Department, led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the April 18, 2017, minutes as circulated. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Ordinance No. 3576.

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3576 on second and final reading. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3576**

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee, Amending Title 18 (Water and Sewers) Chapter 1 (Sewage and Human Excreta Disposal) of the Morristown Municipal Code.**

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Ordinance No. 3577.

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3577 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee, Amending Title 18 (Water and Sewers) Chapter 3 (Sewer Charges) of the Morristown Municipal Code.**

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Ordinance No. 3578.

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3578 on second and final reading. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3578**

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee, Amending Title 18 (Water and Sewers) Chapter 4 (Water Pollution Control) of the Morristown Municipal Code.**

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Resolution No. 05-17.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Resolution No. 05-17. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Resolution No. 05-17**

**A Resolution Adopting a Plan of Services for the Annexation of Property located along West Andrew Johnson Highway.**

A Public Hearing was held pertaining to Ordinance No. 3579.

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3579 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3579**

**Entitled an Ordinance to Annex Certain Territory and to Incorporate Same within the Corporate Boundaries of the City of Morristown, Tennessee. Annexation of property located along West Andrew Johnson Highway having Hamblen County Tax Parcel ID# 032047 07200 with the Zoning Designation of Single Family Residential District, R-2.**

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the modification of joint agreement with U.S. Geological Survey. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the agreement for Employee Assistance Program with One America. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve changing the phone system at Public Works Department to Morristown Utility Systems (MUS) with option to purchase equipment in the amount of \$6,341.31 and monthly rate of \$838.94. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the bid for Fire Department Turnout Gear to Municipal Emergency Services (MES) in the amount of \$2,270. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the task order from Strategic Services Company, LLC (SSC) for Boiler and Chiller at City Hall in the lump sum fee of the following: Scope #1 \$17,700, Scope #2 \$5,000 and Scope #3 \$5,000. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) for Vantage View Project with LDA Engineering in the not to exceed amount of \$22,500. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) Actuarial Study from USI Consulting Group in the not to exceed amount of \$5,500. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve the 2017-14<sup>th</sup> Plan Year – Community Development Block Grant Action Plan – Activities Summaries 7-1-17 to 6-30-18. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to re-appoint Tim Dyke, Jerry Burke and Kevin Rogers to the Construction Board of Adjustments, Appeals and Examiners for a three (3) year term expiring May 1, 2020. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".
