The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 4, 2021, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney presiding and the following Councilmembers present: Al A'Hearn, Chris Bivens, Bob Garrett, Tommy Pedigo, Kay Senter and Ken Smith.

Councilmember Al A'Hearn led in the invocation and "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember A'Hearn made a motion to approve the April 20, 2021 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Chesney opened the floor for citizens comments related to Agenda items. No one spoke.

A Public Hearing was held relating to Ordinance No. 3686; no one spoke.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3686 on second and final reading. Councilmember A'Hearn seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3686

Being an Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee Amending Title 9 of the Morristown Municipal Code (Farmers Market).

A Public Hearing was held relating to Ordinance No. 3651.04; no one spoke.

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3651.04 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3651.04

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 3651, the City of Morristown, Tennessee annual budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and to appropriate additional funds totaling \$274,000 for the design contract with Mattern & Craig for the improvements at East Morris Boulevard and Thompson Creek Road.

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the contract with Murrell Burglar Alarms for a monthly service fee of \$298.44 for Impound Lot Alarm System. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve to declare inventory items as surplus from the Public Works Department and to dispose of properly. Councilmember A'Hearn seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember A'Hearn made a motion to approve to declare inventory items as surplus from the IT Department and to dispose of properly. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember A'Hearn made a motion to approve the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Action Plan. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the PO # 21002200 to Wilson County Motors in the amount of \$52,993.60 via Statewide Contract 209 for the purchase of two (2) 2021 Chevrolet Colorado work trucks for the Parks and Recreation Department. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Morristown and Rotary Noon Club and Rotary AM Club related to the Splash Pad at Morristown Landing. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Chesney opened the floor for members of the audience to speak subject to the guidelines provided. No one spoke.

Mayor Gary Chesney adjourned the May 4, 2021 Morristown City Council meeting at 5:11 p.m.
