JUNE 1, 2021

The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 1, 2021, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney presiding and the following Councilmembers present: Bob Garrett, Tommy Pedigo, Kay Senter and Ken Smith. Absent: Al A'Hearn and Chris Bivens.

Councilmember Smith led in the invocation and "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the May 18, 2021 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Chesney opened the floor for citizens comments related to Agenda items. No one spoke.

A Public Hearing was held relating to Resolution No. 25-21 Plan of Services; No one spoke.

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve Resolution No. 25-21 Plan of Services. Councilmember Garret seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Resolution 25-21

A Resolution adopting a Plan of Services for the annexation of properties identified as Hamblen County Tax Parcel ID#03202515800 located to the south of Dalton Ford Road.

A Public Hearing was held relating to Ordinance No. 3687; no one spoke.

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3687 on second and final reading. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3687

Entitled an Ordinance to Annex Certain Territory and to Incorporate Same within the Corporate Boundaries of the City of Morristown Tennessee. Annexation of property located south of Dalton Ford Road having the Hamblen County Tax Parcel ID # 032025 15800 with the Zoning Designation of High-Density Residential District, R3.

A Public Hearing was held relating to Ordinance No. 3688; no one spoke.

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3688 on second and final reading. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3688

Entitled an Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. Rezoning of Hamblen County Tennessee Tax Parcel ID # 032025 15802, located on the southeastern intersection of Highway 25-E and Dalton Ford Road, from R2 (Medium Density Residential District) to R3 (High Density Residential District).

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3689 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said ordinance for June 15, 2021. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon rollcall; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3689
An Ordinance of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022.

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3651.05 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said ordinance for June 15, 2021. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon rollcall; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3651.05
An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3651, the City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and to appropriate additional funds totaling \$86,500.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve PO # 21002450 to Ari Phoenix, Inc. for the purchase of a lift system for the Public Works Equipment Shop in the amount of \$40,215.97 purchased via Sourcewell Contract # 013020-ARP. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve PO # 21002451 to Mohawk Lifts, LLC for the purchase of two tire changers for the Public Equipment Shop in the amount of \$28,199.89 purchased via Sourcewell Contract # 013020-MRL. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the Proposal No. 12-20608 from GEOServices, LLC for additional services for Morristown Landing in the estimated amount not to exceed \$100,000. Councilmember Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to surplus miscellaneous items from the Public Works Communications Department. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to appoint Ventrus Norfolk to the Morristown-Hamblen Solid Waste Board to fill the unexpired term of John Hofer; term expiring October 1, 2023. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

City Administrator Tony Cox reported on Line Item Transfers from the Drug Control Fund #126, Solid Waste Fund #435, and Storm Water Fund #440. He then reported on the Annual Debt Report for the year ending June 30, 2021.


Mayor Chesney opened the floor for members of the audience to speak subject to the guidelines provided; Linda Noe spoke.

Mayor Gary Chesney adjourned the June 1, 2021 Morristown City Council meeting at 5:28 p.m.
